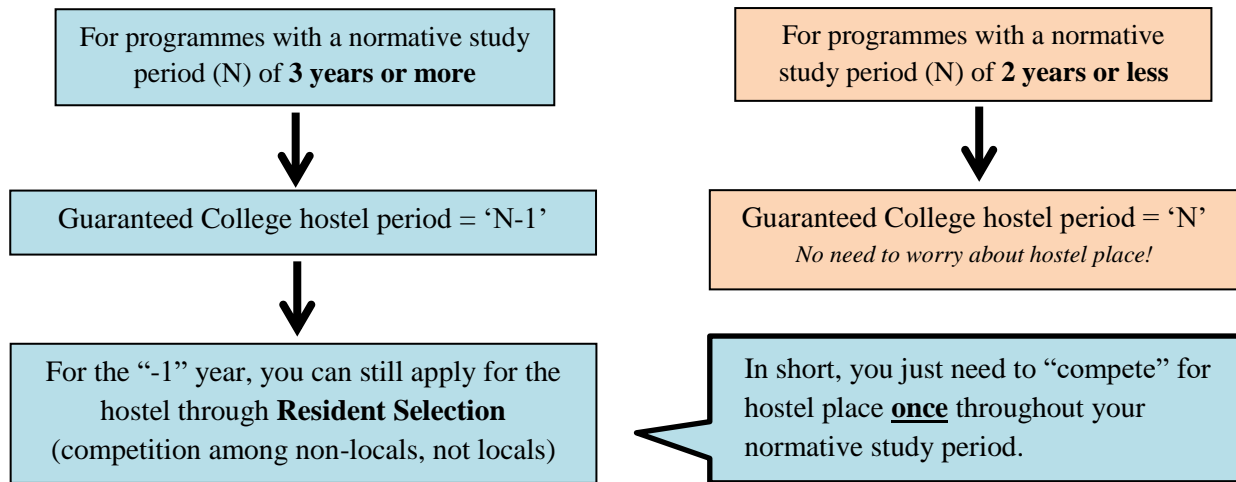


Fact Sheet on Hostel Accommodation for Non-Local Students Admitted in 2016/17 and after

1) Know your Guaranteed College Hostel Period!

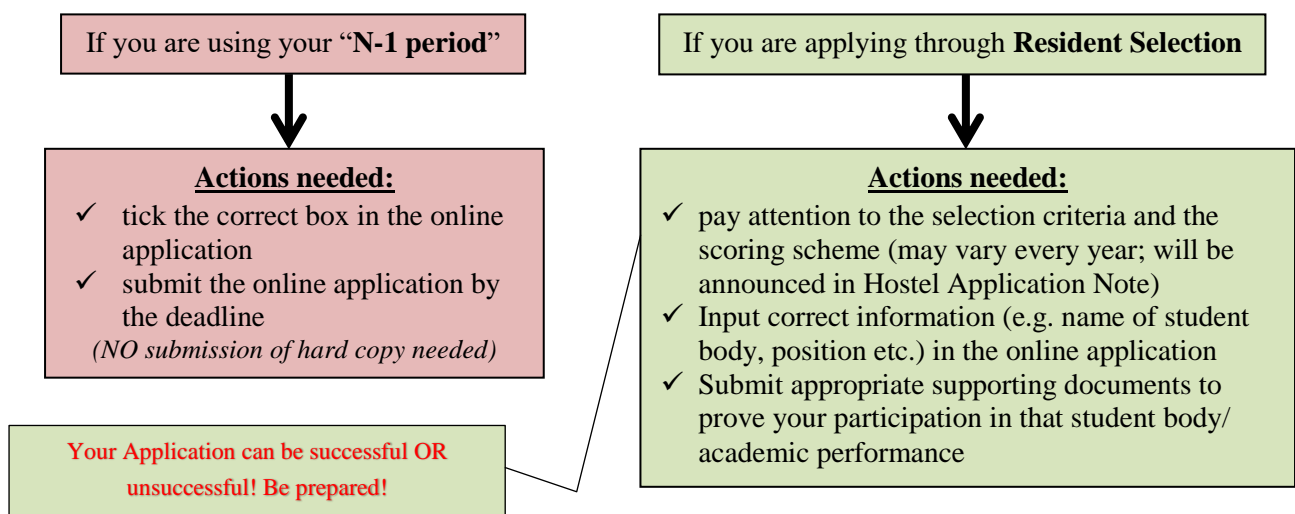


2) Hostel Application at the First Year of Study (around late August in your admission year)

- Hostel accommodation is guaranteed in the First Year of Study upon application.
- Paper application forms will be distributed to non-local freshmen of the College **during the Mainland Undergraduate Association/International Student Association Orientation Camp**. Those who do not attend the orientation camp will also receive the form **by email**. Please complete and return to the College Office according to the instructions.
- **No application = No hostel place!**

3) Hostel Application AFTER First Year of Study (around October/ November every year)

- Every year, the hostel application for non-freshmen takes place around October/ November. Please pay attention to the College's e-newsletter "The Sunny Weekly", mass emails sent by the College and the College website (<http://www.wys.cuhk.edu.hk/>).
- The online application for non-local students is **different** from that for local students. Follow the correct link provided and **DO NOT** mix up.
- In the online application, you will be asked whether this year you are using your "guaranteed hostel quota" (i.e. your N-1 period), or you are applying for the hostel through **Resident Selection**.



* Remarks: You can choose to apply through **Resident Selection** in **EITHER** one year of study after first year, not necessarily in your final year.

4) Outgoing Exchange

To enhance students' international exposure, hostel residence at a foreign education institute during your outgoing exchange is **NOT** counted in the "N-1" period.

5) Suspension of Study

NO hostel place will be allotted to College students during their Suspension of Study.

6) Maximum College Hostel Period

The maximum College hostel period for each student equals his/her normative study period.

How to calculate YOUR normative study period UPON ADMISSION?

EXAMPLE:

Log in to CUSIS > Mystudy > My Academics -- Normative study period

= From Admit Term to Normative Study End Term

= from 2017/18 Term 1 to 2019/20 Term

= 6 terms

*remarks: normative study end terms may change when students go on exchange/ apply for suspension of study. **One should calculate this at admission!**

7) Hostel Residence Beyond Normative Study Period

If you extend your CUHK undergraduate study, you can still apply for a hostel place through **Resident Selection**, given that your College hostel period has not yet reached the maximum.

Example:

- Your Normative Study Period = 4 years
- Your "N-1 period": Year 1, Year 2 and Year 4
- You applied for the hostel through **Resident Selection** in Year 3 but it was unsuccessful, hence you did not live in the College hostel.
- Your College hostel period (3 years) < Your Normative Study Period (4 years)
- You can apply for the hostel through **Resident Selection** during your extension of study

Miscellaneous on Hostel Life

Hostel Check-out

Term-time hostel residence usually ends in May every year. Students will need to check out of the hostel and clear all their personal belongings.

Even if you have applied to stay at the hostel during the summer, you will be assigned to a room different from your term-time room!
Be prepared to pack at the end of each academic year!

Temporary Luggage Storage

Non-local students are allowed to temporarily store up to 2 pieces of luggage at the College in the summer. Terms and conditions apply (check application note every year). So.....
