- Return the completed form to the Dean of Students' Office.
- Successful applicant will receive email notification with amount of assistance and payment arrangement.
- Applicant are required to committed to fulfilling the following obligations:
 - Submit a trip report (about 500 Chinese or English words) and 2 photos at least within two weeks after your return to Hong Kong, for public release in College home page, publications and on display boards, etc.
 - To assist the College in promoting cultural and exchange activities.
