
Formation of groups

- Industrial Revolution: specialization and division of labor (Smith, 1776)
- Definition: **Two** or more interacting and interdependent individuals who come together to achieve specific **goals**.


- Types of groups
 - 1. Formal groups: work groups defined by the organization's structure that have designated work assignments and tasks;
 - Informal groups: groups that are independently formed to meet the social needs of their members
