## General notes for students taking Japanese language courses

### JASP1450/1460/2450/2460 (New Practical Japanese I/II/III/IV)

- Due to fast progress of the course, students are strongly advised to complete the add/drop as soon as possible during the add/drop period.
- Because of the limit of classroom capacity, all students on the wait lists are specially arranged to attend lessons temporarily on ZOOM synchronically during the first week and E-add-drop period in 2022-23 Term 2. Please pay attention to the related announcements on Blackboard. If you have any difficulties in accessing the ZOOM details on Blackboard, please contact the course TAs for assistance:

- Students must obtain Grade C- or above to be qualified to take the succeeding level courses. Students will be asked to drop the succeeding course should they fail to meet this requirement, even though they have successfully registered in the succeeding course through CUSIS.
- Students who do not attend class without medical certificate or strong reasons will result in mark deduction. Students who do not attend one-third of classes may fail the subject. For details, please refer to the regulations distributed in the first lesson.
- Postgraduate students who are interested in taking the language courses are required to send a written request with the **completed CS-1 form** (<https://www.gs.cuhk.edu.hk/download/CS1.pdf>) along with both the student's and supervisor's signatures, course code, course title, class session and personal information to Ms. Rebecca Leung at [rebeccaykleung@cuhk.edu.hk](mailto:rebeccaykleung@cuhk.edu.hk) to do the registration in advance. Colleagues will contact you whether your course registration will be approved or not. Registration is on a *first-come, first-served* basis and starts **from 14 November 2022 till 14 January 2023**. Please be reminded that the approved CS-1 form must be returned to the Graduate School by the end of the course registration/add/drop periods for enrolling any undergraduate language courses outside the prescribed study scheme.

Students who have passed the placement test for language course

Students who have passed the placement test and/or are exempted for a particular language course due to prior knowledge of Japanese are only allowed to take language courses at level higher than the exempted course.

### **ADD/DROP Arrangement**

Please note that NOT all add/drop could be done in the CUSIS system. You must check information on CUSIS whether you are required to send a written request to the Department to add/drop a particular course.
