<u>REMARKS</u>

- 1. Fee items included in student invoice may vary according to agreement between home university and CUHK.
- 2. <u>Passport holders of Taiwan</u>: Visa application fee (HK\$630) is for visa sponsorship and application submission by CUHK to the Hong Kong Immigration Department (ImmD) as well as collection and shipping student visa label (entry permit) by courier.
- 3. <u>All other passport holders</u>: Visa application fee (HK\$100) is for visa sponsorship and application submission by CUHK to the Hong Kong Immigration Department (ImmD). E-Visa fee of HK\$230 is for downloading the e-Visa when it is available. Students will be contacted in due course to settle the e-Visa fee directly with the ImmD online
- 4. Caution money is a security deposit for using campus facilities. Students should fill out a credit card payment authorization form for their caution money upon arrival. This credit card payment will not be processed unless students have outstanding fees at CUHK after completion of the programme.
- 5. Fees paid are neither refundable nor transferable under any circumstances.
