Information Sheet

The HKEX Foundation Scholarship will be granted for undergraduate studies in the fields of business and finance.

Number and Amount of Award

There will be one non-renewable scholarship of HK\$50,000.

Eligibility

To be eligible, the applicants must:

- be local full-time undergraduate students from the Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Engineering or Department of Economics;
- be studying a discipline which is related to Business, Economics, Finance or Financial technology;
- be pursuing their first degree during the tenure of the Scholarship;
- be within their normative study period when applying for the Scholarship; and
- have attained a Cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 up to Term 1 of the academic year 2022/23.

The scholarship recipient is NOT allowed to concurrently hold other scholarships/awards. If he/she has already received other scholarships or awards in the academic year 2022/23, he/she must relinquish the relevant awards when accepting the HKEX Foundation Scholarship.

Application Procedures

- 2. Please read all the application documents carefully and follow the instructions strictly.
- 3. Completed application form together with all requisite documents should be submitted to the Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Engineering or the Department of Economics (depending on which academic unit you are affiliated to) on or before 13

 February 2023. Please check with the Faculties or Department concerned for the submission method. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Please refer to the Notes for Applicants attached to the application form for the requisite documents to be submitted by the applicants.
- 4. The University Selection Panel will shortlist suitable candidates for final selection by the donor.
- 5. The awardee will be selected by the donor through an interview.
- 6. The decisions of the University Selection Panel and the donor are final and not subject to review, and the reasons for shortlisting, nominating, granting or refusing to offer an award will not be given.
