The Scholarship

To help Hong Kong's next generation prepare for a future that is increasingly intertwined with the Greater Bay Area (GBA), the HSBC Greater Bay Area (Hong Kong) Scholarship is offered to encourage Hong Kong students to acquire the necessary skills and knowledge that will help them become competitive, confident, and employable as they pursue a successful and rewarding career in GBA.

♦ Value of the Scholarship

Each awardee will receive a scholarship award of HK\$80,000. Awardees will also be offered non-financial support and GBA-related learning opportunities, e.g. mentorship and internship.

♦ Eligibility

To be eligible, the applicants must:

- be full-time undergraduate students studying any discipline;
- be Hong Kong permanent residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong;
- have obtained a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or stand within top 15% of class/department in the first term of 2022/23; and
- be committed to pursuing employment, entrepreneurship or advanced academic opportunities in GBA.
