1st Speaker: Dr. CHOI Pui Wah

Dr. Choi completed her undergraduate and PhD study in Biochemistry at CUHK. After graduating from the PhD study, She joined Harvard Medical School as a postdoctoral research fellow. After completing the postdoc training, she joined two biotech companies as a research officer and senior scientist for developing detection of mutations in cancer with cell-free DNA and immunotherapy for GI cancer. After gaining intensive start-up and commercialization training, she starts building her own deep-tech start-up company. She joined Entrepreneur First, a UK start-up accelerator and UIBE Bauhinia Valley Start-up Camp in Beijing to strengthen her knowledge in marketing, value proposition, patent application, company management and business development. Her business proposals and pitching decks were awarded the 1st runner up at the UIBE Bauhinia Valley Start-up Camp and HK Techathon. She is currently the founder and CEO of WomenX Biotech Limited which develops biotechnology to improve women's health. WomenX is funded by HK Science Park's Incubio Program & STEP program, ITC Patent grant and STEM student internship scheme.

2nd Speaker: Mr. LEE Yat Shing, Eric

Mr. Eric Lee received his MPhil degree in Biochemistry from CUHK in 2017 and completed his postgraduate diploma in education (PGDE) in Biology at HKU in 2018. He is now a Biology teacher in Wah Yan College, Kowloon. In this talk, he will share his experience of being a research student, and how he extended the interest in studying and doing sciences to the field of science education.
