



CUHK Vice-Chancellor's PhD Scholarship Scheme (2021-22 Intake)

What the Scheme Offers

The Scholarship Scheme offers the following to selected candidates with outstanding academic performance (obtained a minimum CGPA of 3.5 out of 4.0 or equivalent), and obtained a *PhD admission offer from a top-50 overseas university* for 2021-22:

- ❖ An award of total **HK\$80,000** HK\$40,000 in the first year and HK\$20,000 each in the second and third years of study subject to satisfactory study progress; and
- ❖ Studentships of **HK\$216,300 per annum** within the normative study period.

If you were being offered a PhD place in top overseas universities but have to change your study plan due to the recent pandemic or travel restriction, CUHK offers a Vice-Chancellor's PhD Scholarship Scheme for you to realise your study goal!
