- 5) enhance students' generic competencies of innovative problem solving, communication and teamwork through service learning; and
- 6) understand yourself, your team and help them flourishing.

**SSeedS** also create a platform for members to practice how to be an everyday leader. Both **SSeedS** members (the peer mentors) and the secondary students can benefit through life on life interaction.

## SSeedS members who successfully complete the scheme can

- 1. receive a certificate of mental health first-aid:
