Study Scheme for Students Admitted in 2010-11 and Thereafter

1. Coursework requirement:

24 units of coursework for graduation

A. Required courses: 6 units

- **HIST 5011A** : “Perspectives in Comparative and Public History”; **OR**
- **HIST 5011B** : 「比較史及公眾史的視野」; **AND**
- One course **EITHER** from “Special Topics in Public History” 「公眾歷史特別專題」 **OR** “Special Topics in Comparative History” 「比較史特別專題」



Study Scheme for Students Admitted in 2010-11 and Thereafter

B. Elective courses from:

- **HIST 5000**-level courses; **OR**
- **HIST 6015, HIST 6016, HIST 6017**

Remarks:

With prior approval from the course teacher, MA Programme Director and Division Head, students may choose 3 units of HIST4000-level course offered by the History Department. These will be counted towards course units for graduation if **a grade of B- or above** is achieved.

3. More about the new regulations:

- **Academic probation system:**

A student will be put on academic probation if the cumulative grade point average (GPA) is below 2.0 in the preceding term.

- **Discontinuation of Studies:**

A student shall be required to discontinue studies if:

- he/she has obtained a GPA of 1.0 or below; **OR**
- he/she fails to have probation lifted after being put on academic probation for TWO consecutive terms of attendance; **OR**
- Clause 14.0 “Unsatisfactory Performance and Discontinuation of Studies of the General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies” at http://www2.cuhk.edu.hk/gss/download/pdf/handbook/B03_GRGP.pdf

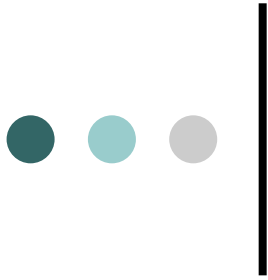

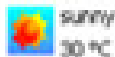
