## Academic probation system:

A student will be put on academic probation if the cumulative grade point average (GPA) is below 2.0 in the preceding term.

- he/she fails to have probation lifted after being put on academic probation for TWO consecutive terms of attendance; OR
- Clause 14.0 "Unsatisfactory Performance and Discontinuation of Studies of the General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies" at


