1. Course Overview:

This course aims at introducing the basic theological concepts of Christology, ecclesiology and pneumatology. The theological discussions, debate and implications among those three concepts would be discussed through historical-theological approach. Furthermore, as a theological discipline, students are expected to learn how to integrate these three Christian doctrines with other elements within the Christian faith.

2. Course Intended Learning Outcomes (CILOs):

	On completion of this course, students should be able to:
CILO 1	Understand the complicated Christian concepts of Christology, pneumatology and
	ecclesiology, and their historical interconnection with the intellectual backgrounds.
CILO 2	Apply the concepts and ideas to evaluate the relevance of their numerous implications.
CILO 3	Reflect on their own beliefs and value towards Christian ideas.

3. Teaching and Learning Activities (TLAs):

CILO 1 Students will: Approach and describe various key ideas and historical events in approaching these three concepts in the development of the Christian thought through discussion, written exercise and group project. Evaluate the comments given by different theories and concepts towards the relationship between Christianity and her contexts. CILO 2 Students will Identify and examine different aspects of the relationship between these three doctrines and other related concepts by participating class discussions and reading. Evaluate the religious import of the different aspects of these three doctrines.

5. Assessment:

All students can choose "Set A" or "Set B" for your own assessment:

Set A:

1. Group Presentation: (30%)

Students (3-5) are formed into different groups to present the reading materials in the tutorials. Basic summary and critical discussions are required. High mark would be given to those groups which can address the advanced theological scholarships. The time is around 30-45 mins.

2. Short Reflection Paper (40%)

Students should write 2 short reflection papers without footnotes and quotations for the following two topics:

- 2.1.Write a paper on the relationship between Christology and Ecclesiology.(20%). The word count is not less than 2000 words. The deadline for submission is Nov 7.
- 2.2. Write a paper on the relationship between Pneumatology and Ecclesiology. (20%). The word count is not less than 2000 words. The deadline for submission is Dec 20.
- 3. Book Report: (30%)
 - Students are required to finish a book review on the following book:
 Kathryn Tanner, *Jesus, Humanity and the Trinity*. Minneapolis: Fortress Press, 2001. (The Chinese translation was published.《耶穌、人性與三一一淺談系統神學》) Chapter 1-3. The deadline for submission is Dec 20.

Set B:

1. Group Presentation: (30%)

Students (3-5) are formed into different groups to present the reading materials in the tutorials. Basic summary and critical discussions are required. High

- mark would be given to those groups which can address the advanced theological scholarships. The time is around 30-45 mins.
- 2. Research paper: (40%) Student is required to submit a research paper on a given topic. The thesis should include clear thesis, arguments and related scholarship. The word count is not less than 4000 words. The deadline for submission is Dec 20.
- 3. Book Report: (30%)
 - ➤ Students are required to finish a book review on the following book:
