## **Jockey Club Museum of Climate Change (MOCC)**

The Jockey Club Museum of Climate Change was established in December 2013 at CUHK. It is the first museum of its kind in the world. Among its various activities, it regularly organises interactive multimedia exhibitions, featuring valuable collections and providing information about climate change. These exhibitions are designed to keep visitors abreast of the latest developments in environmental conservation and sustainability and to persuade them, especially students and teachers, to rally to the cause of environmental stewardship. Since its inception, the museum has hosted over 1.2 million exhibition visitors and reached out to millions of members of the public through its off-site educational activities and promotional efforts.
