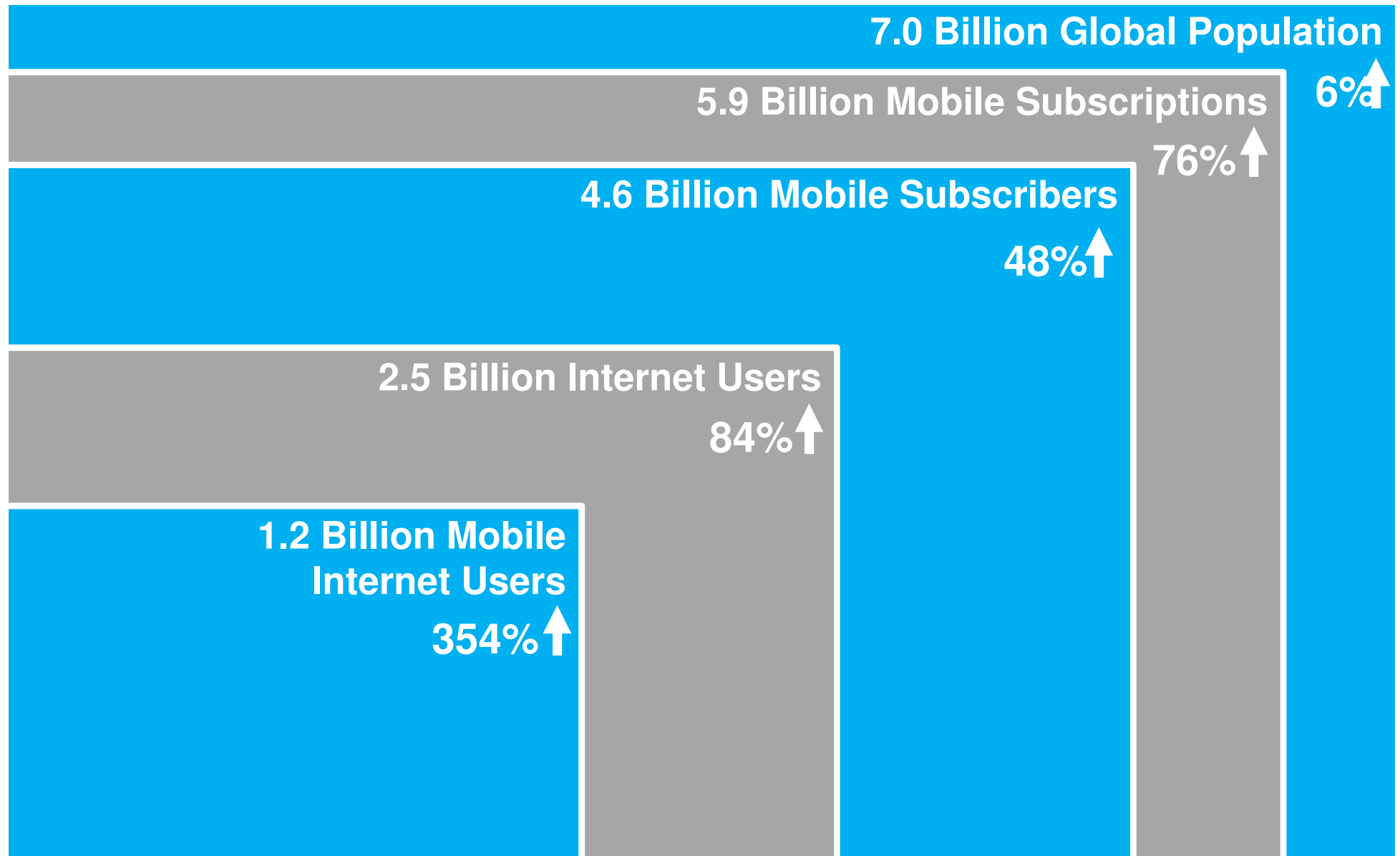

The Digital World in 2012: Growth since 2007

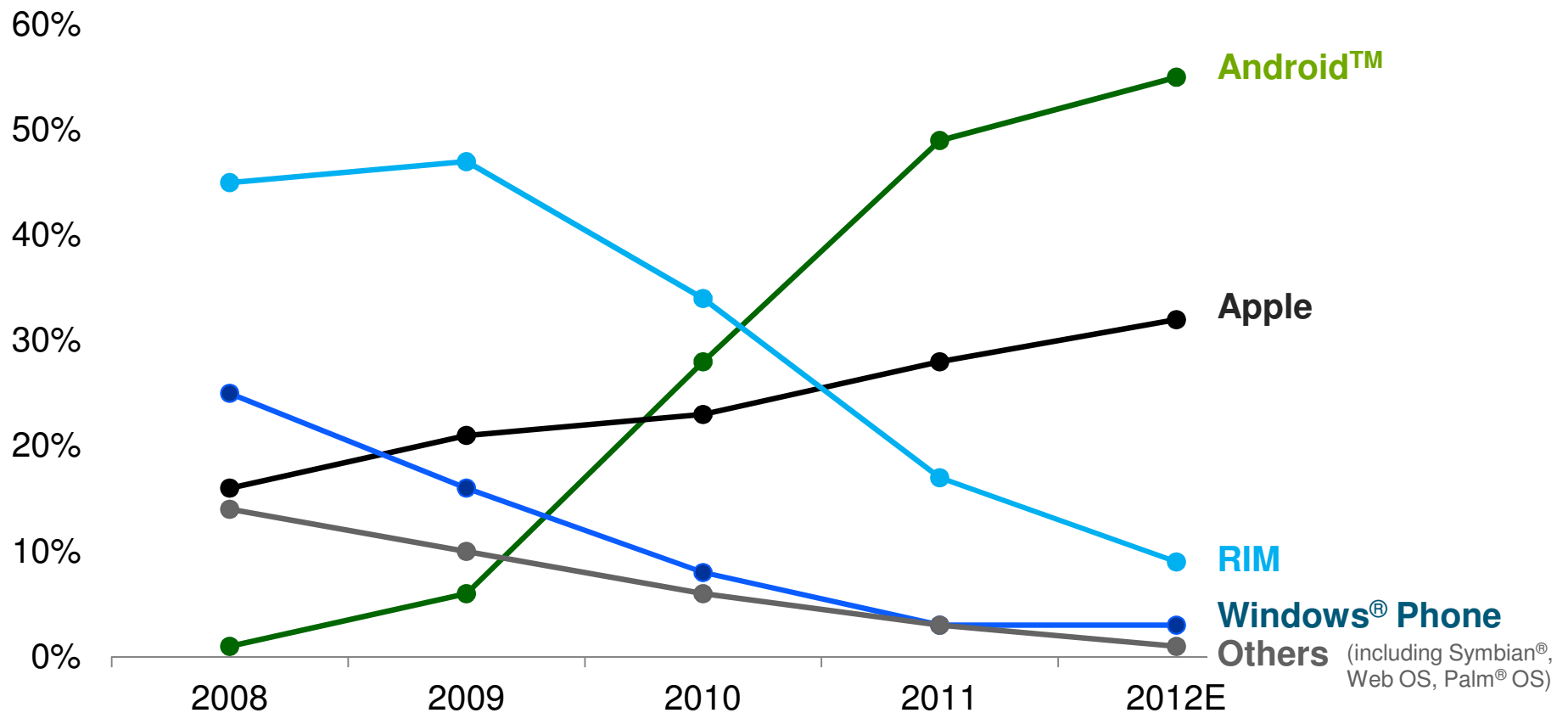

Share of Global Mobile Installed Base of Smartphone OS



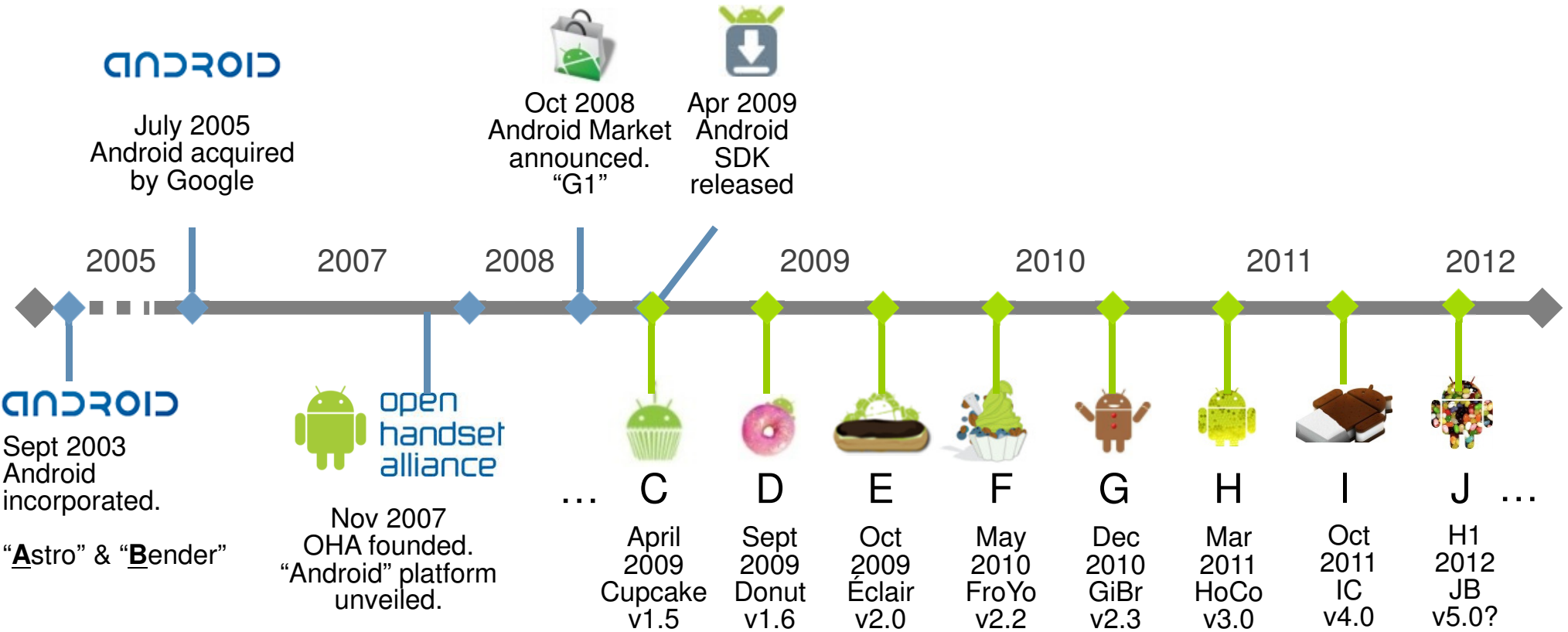

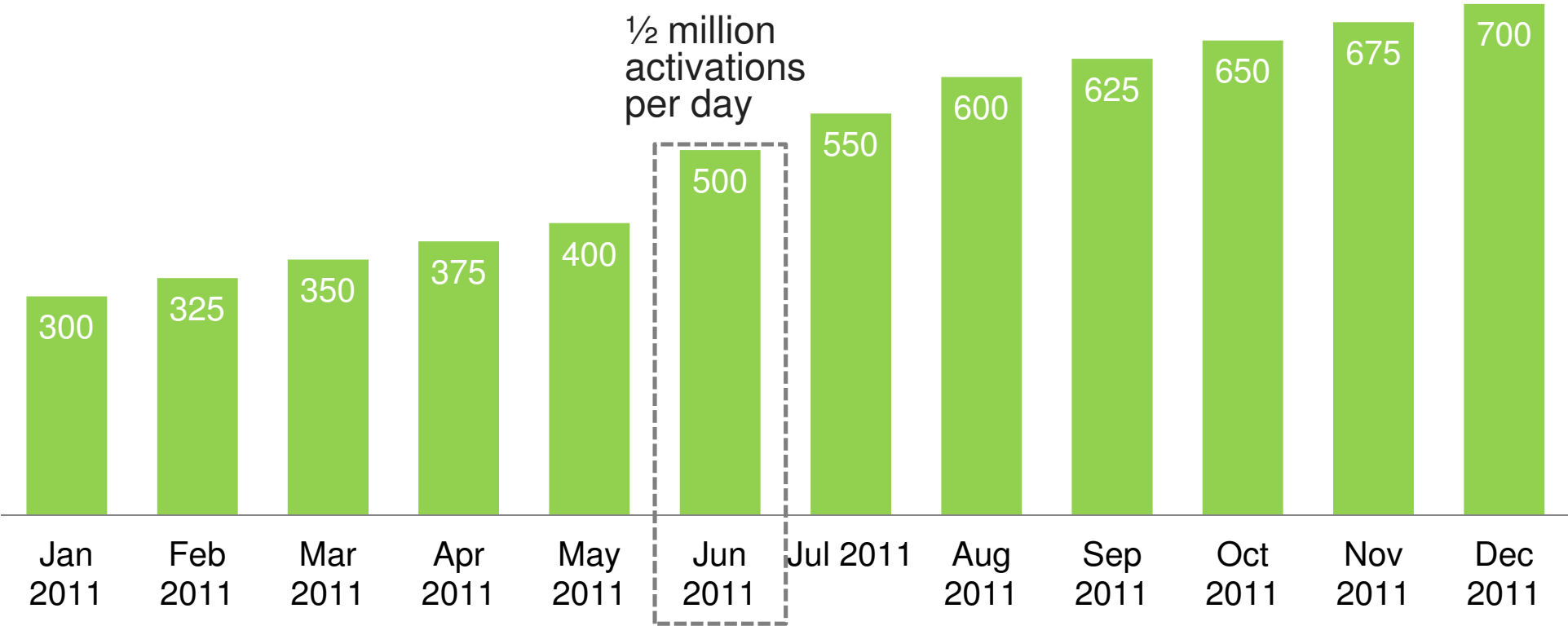

Monthly Android™ Device Activations 2011, Thousands per day

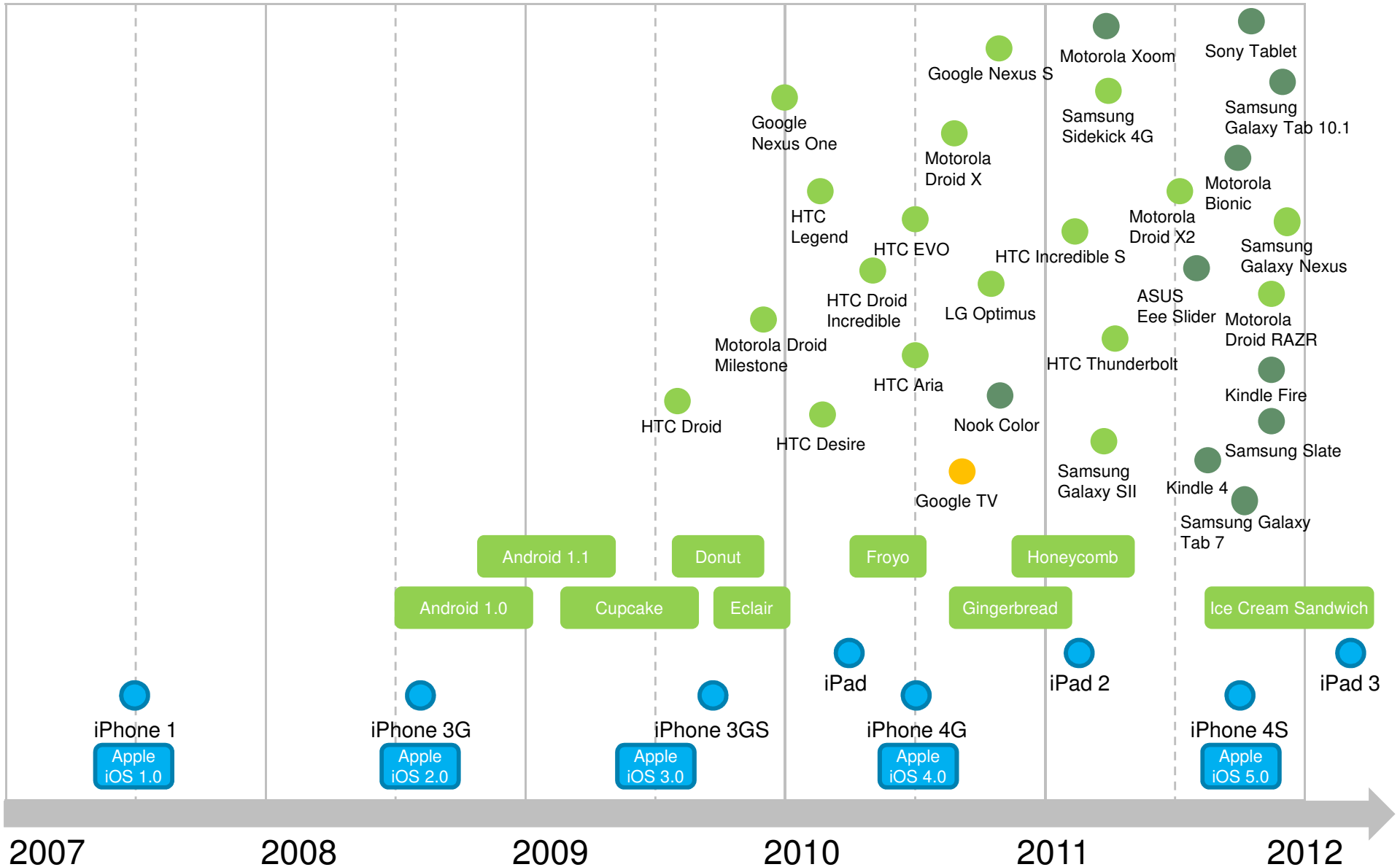

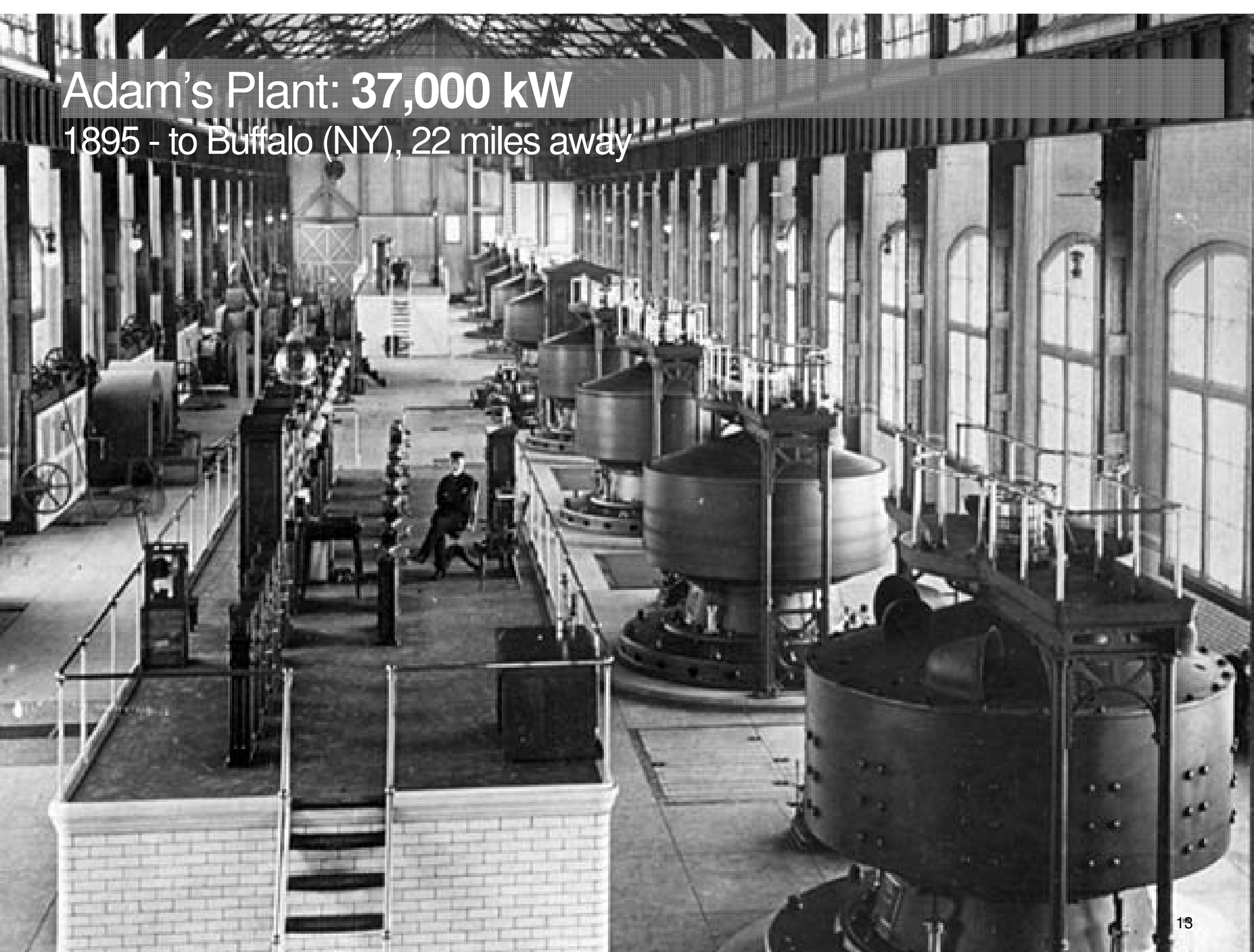

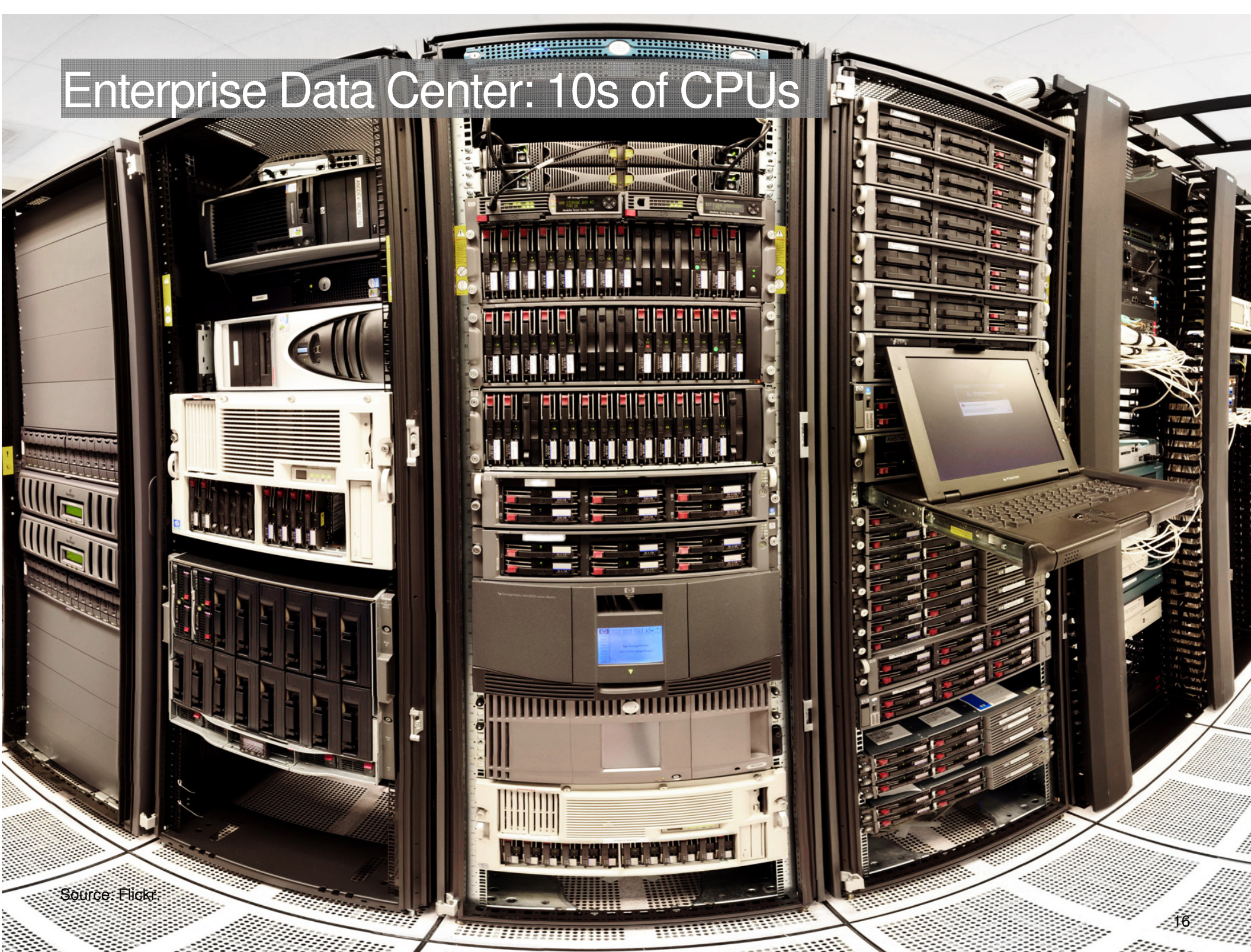

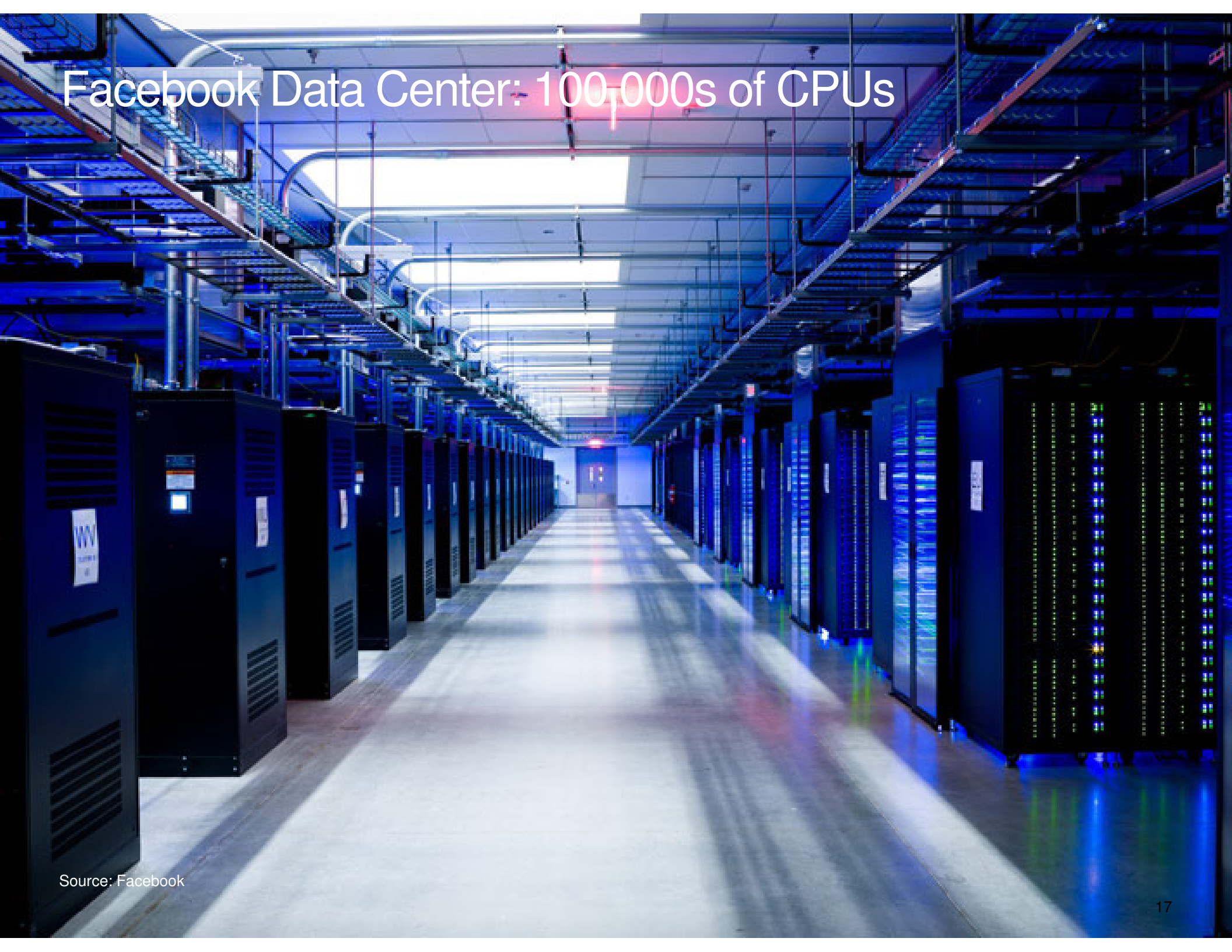

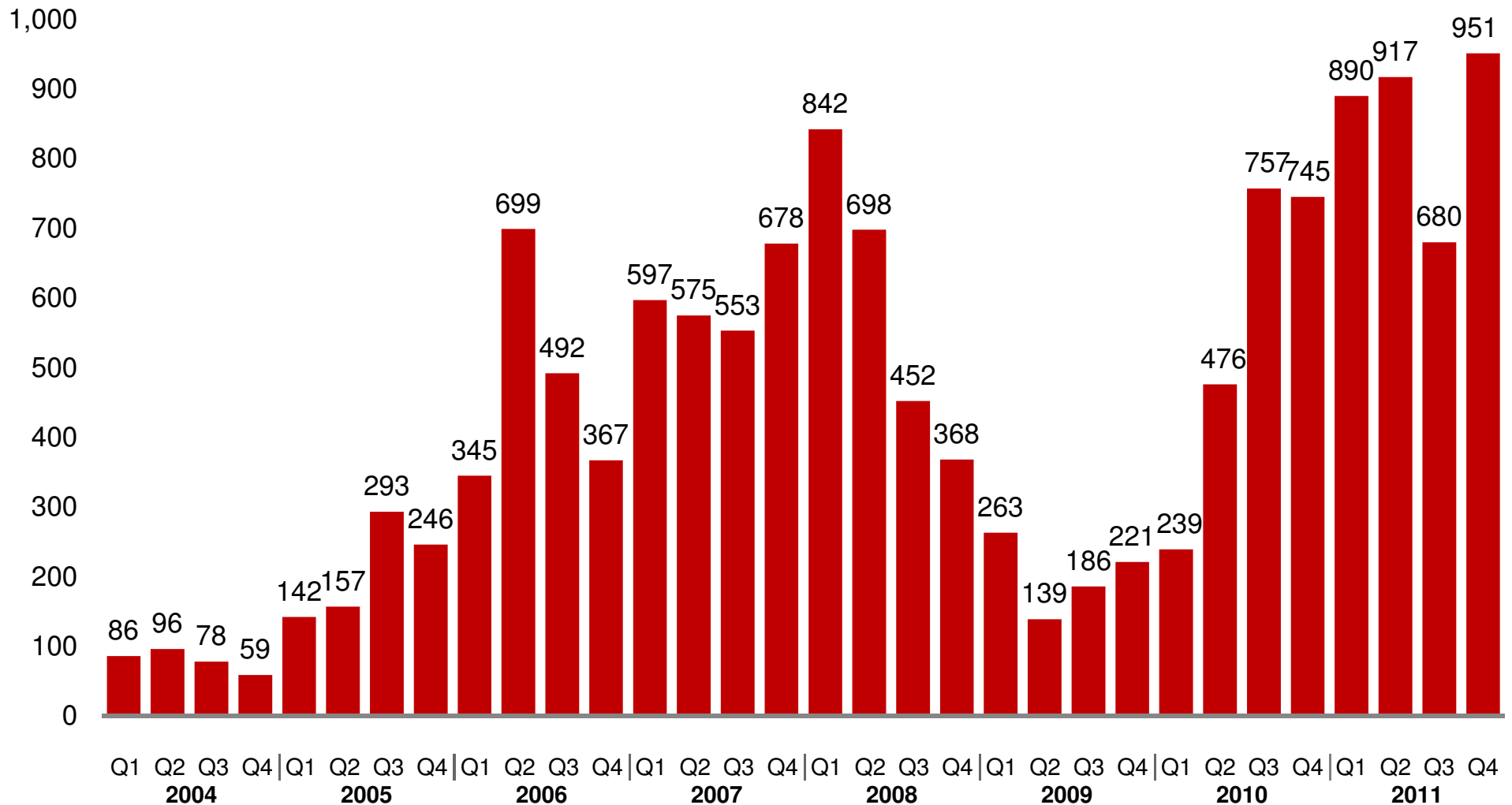

Google Inc. Quarterly Capex, Q1 2004 – Q2 2011, Million USD

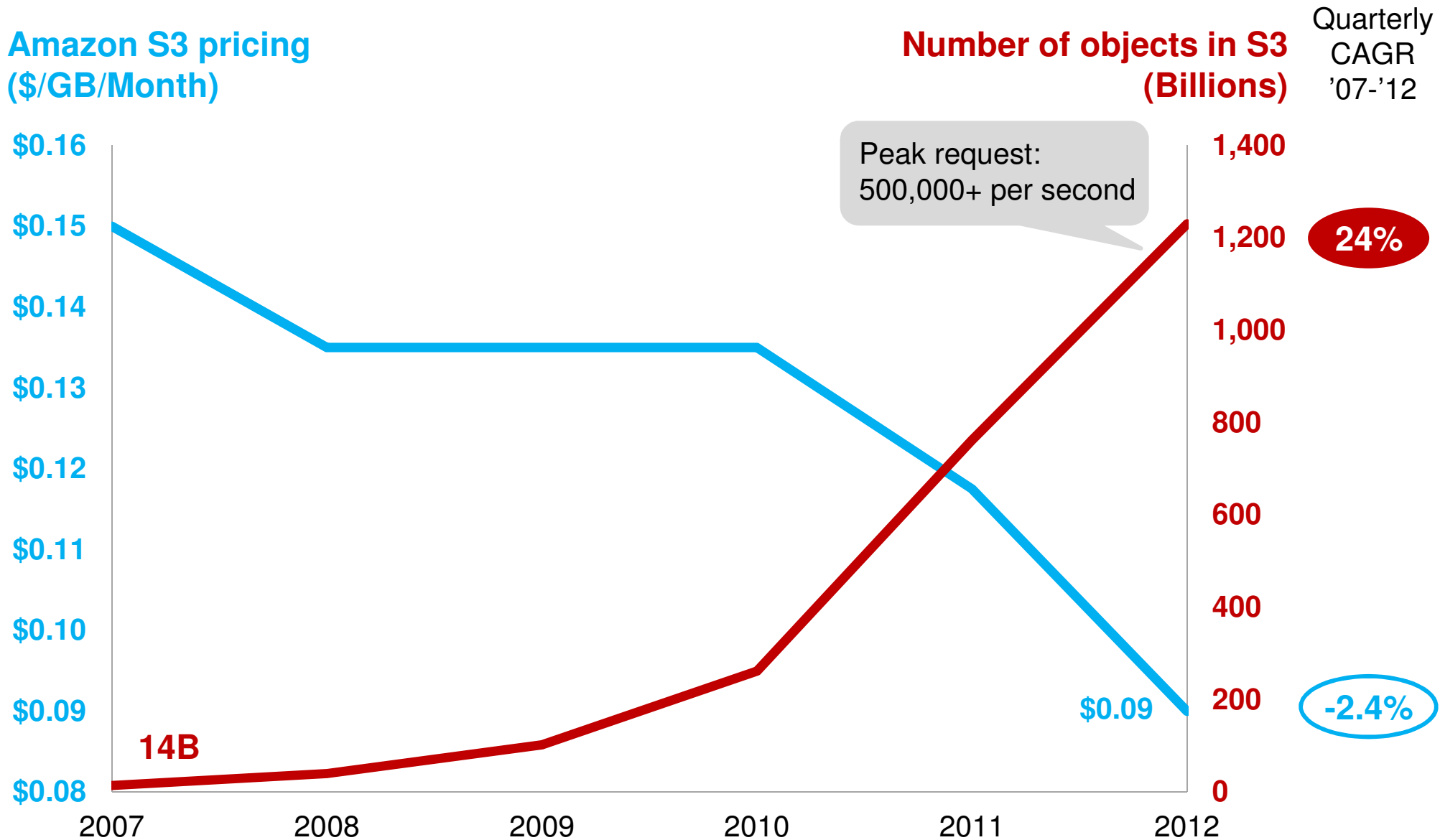

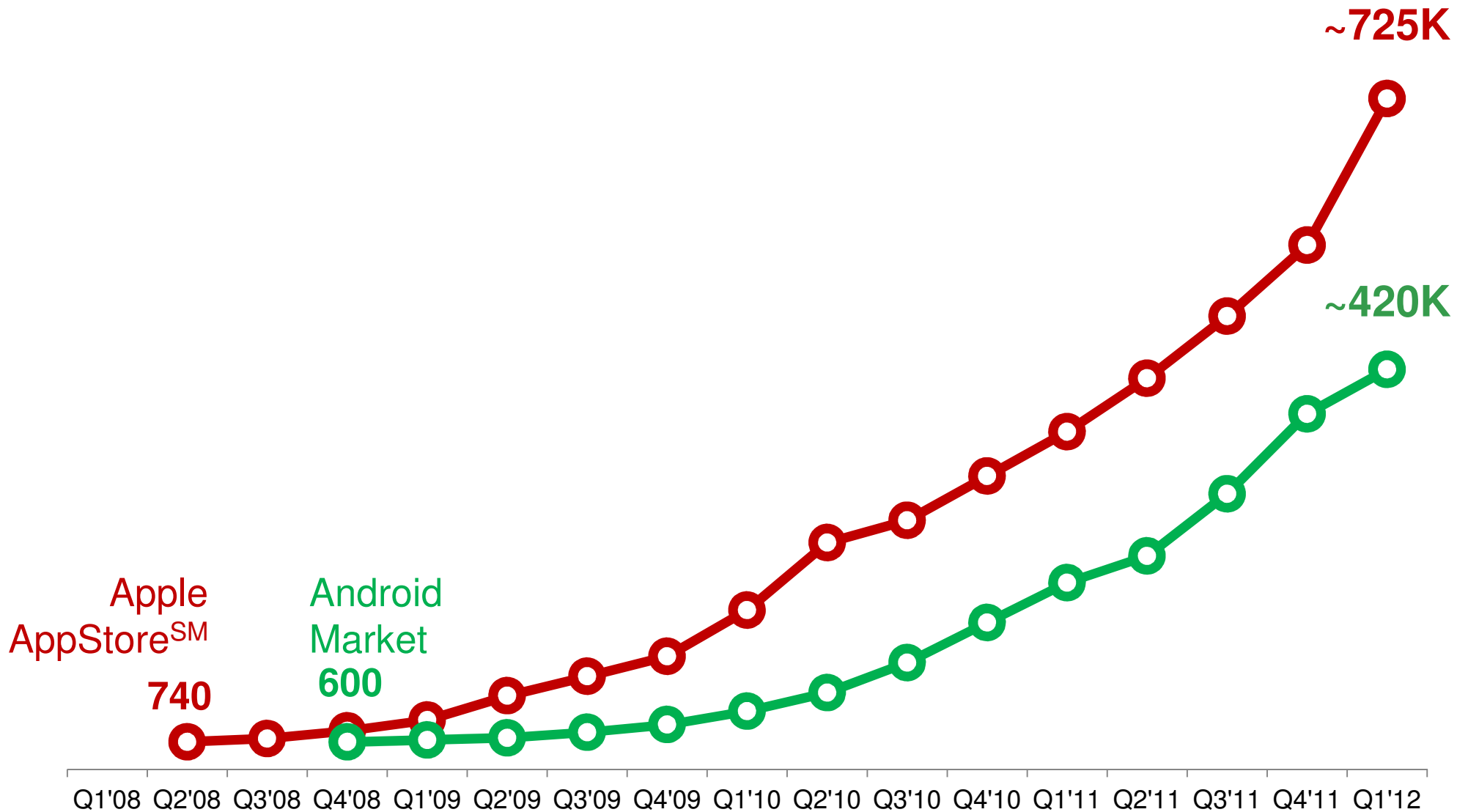

Catalog size Apple AppStoreSM & Android Market, by quarter



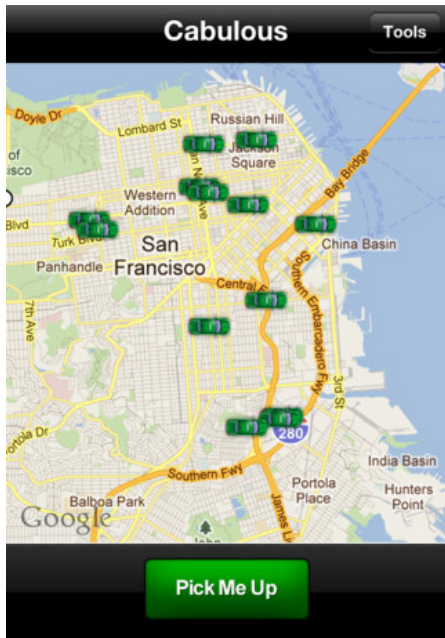

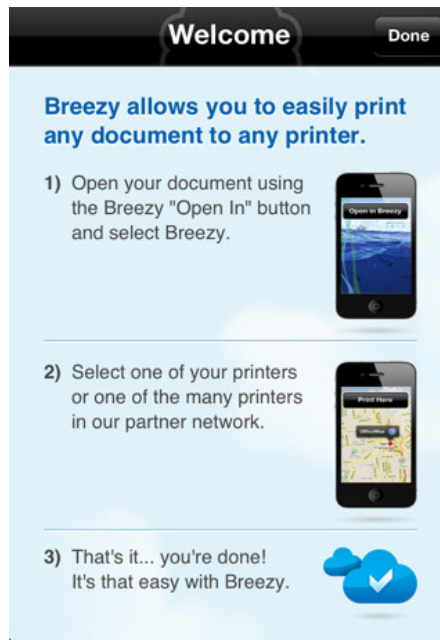

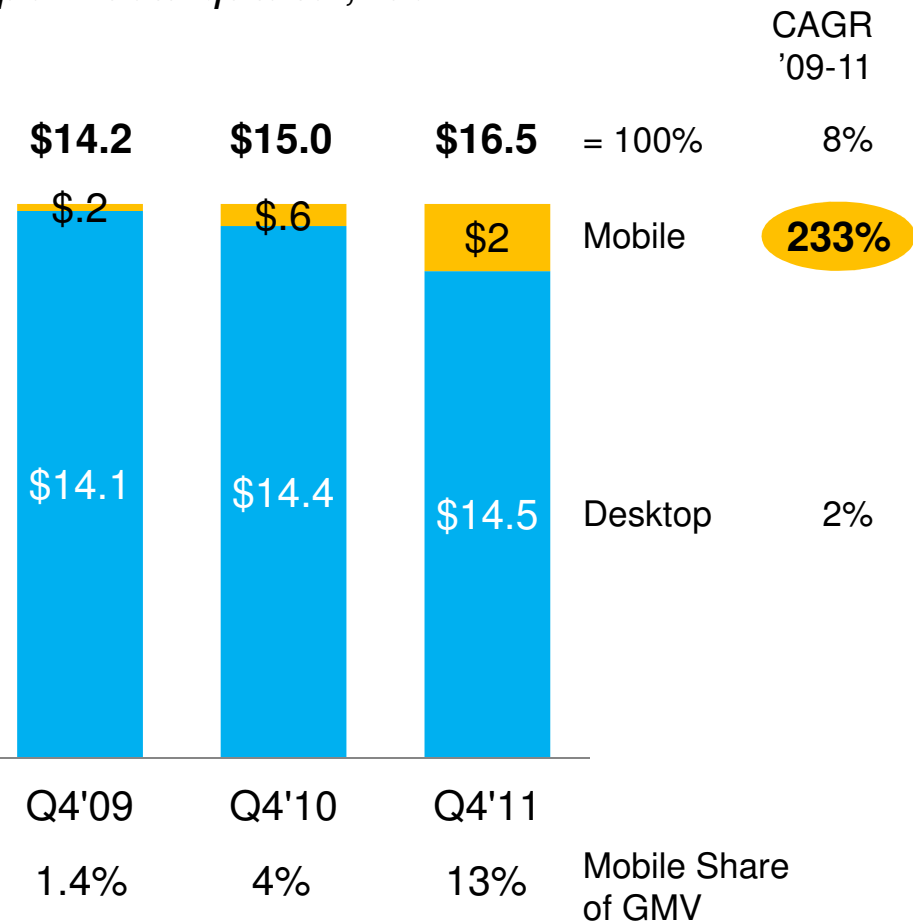

Accelerating volume growth for eBay's mobile apps.

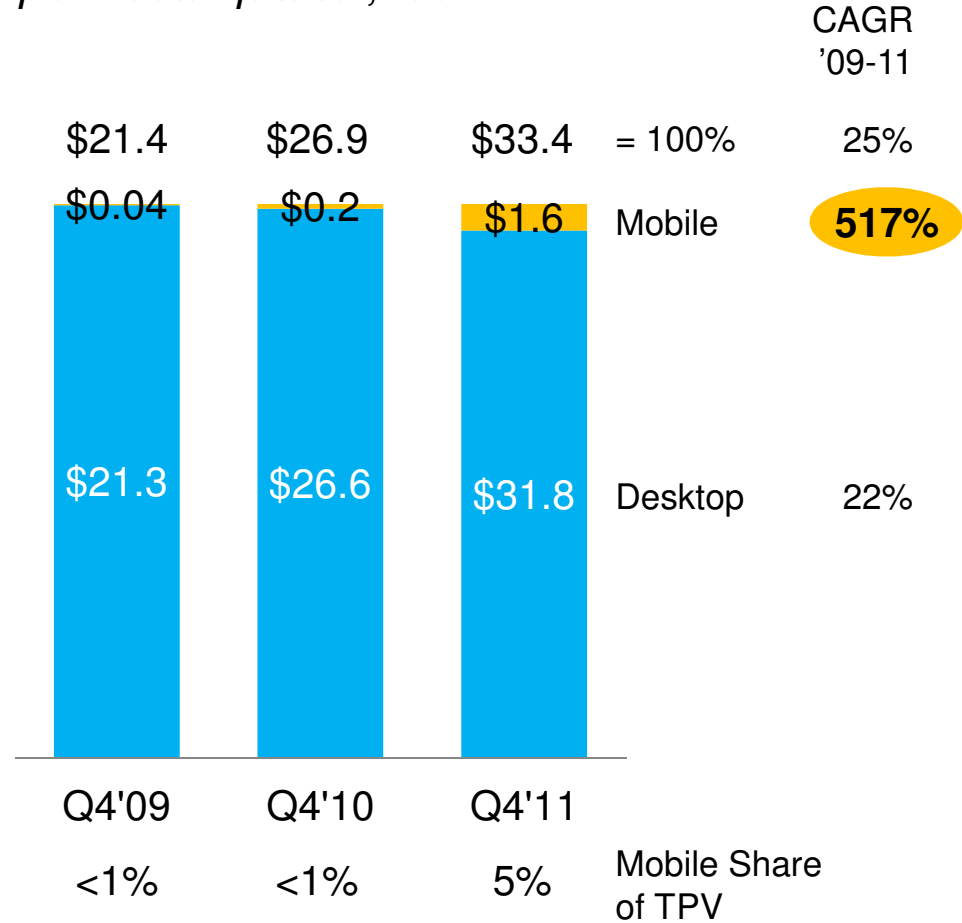
eBay Marketplaces GMV (US\$B)

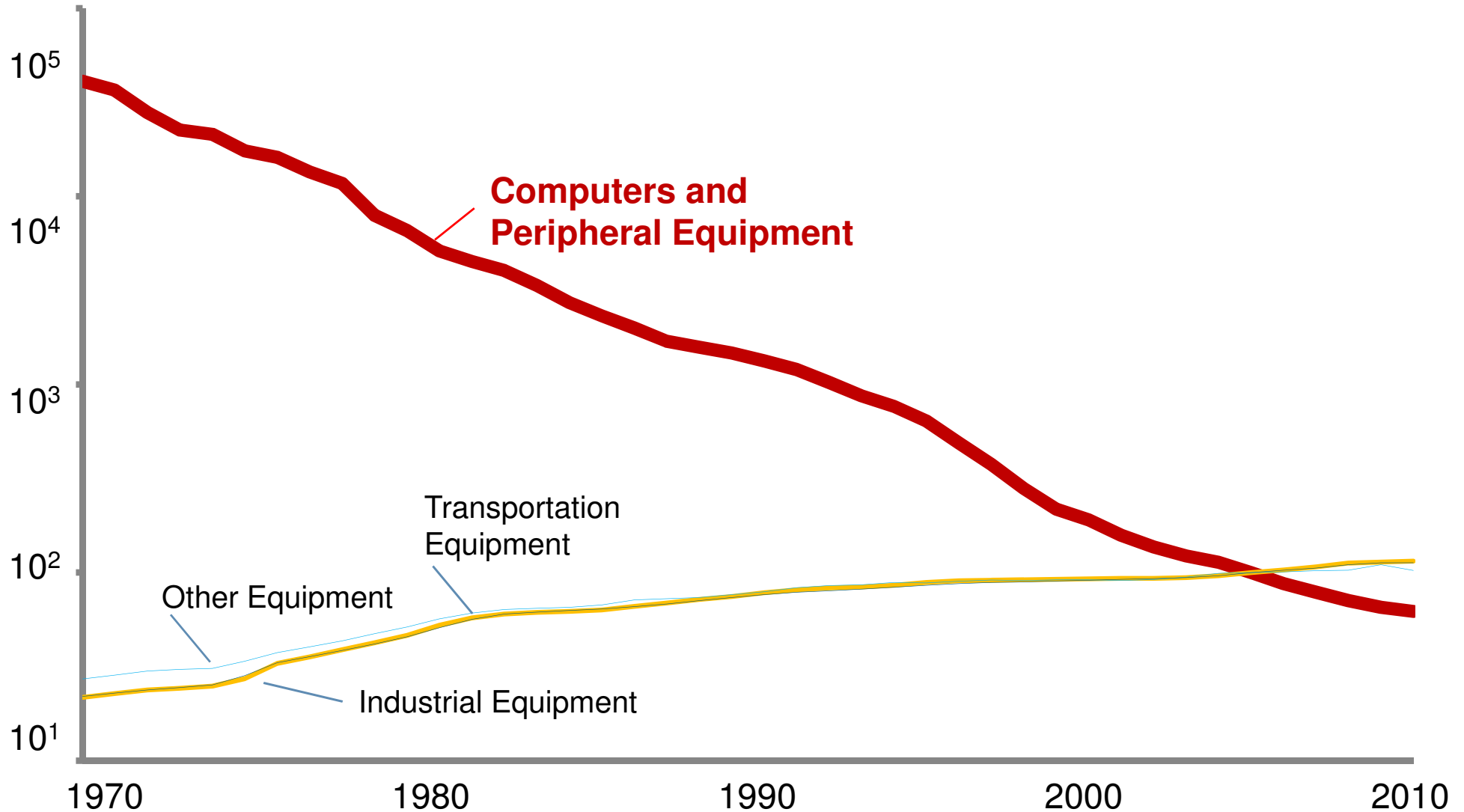

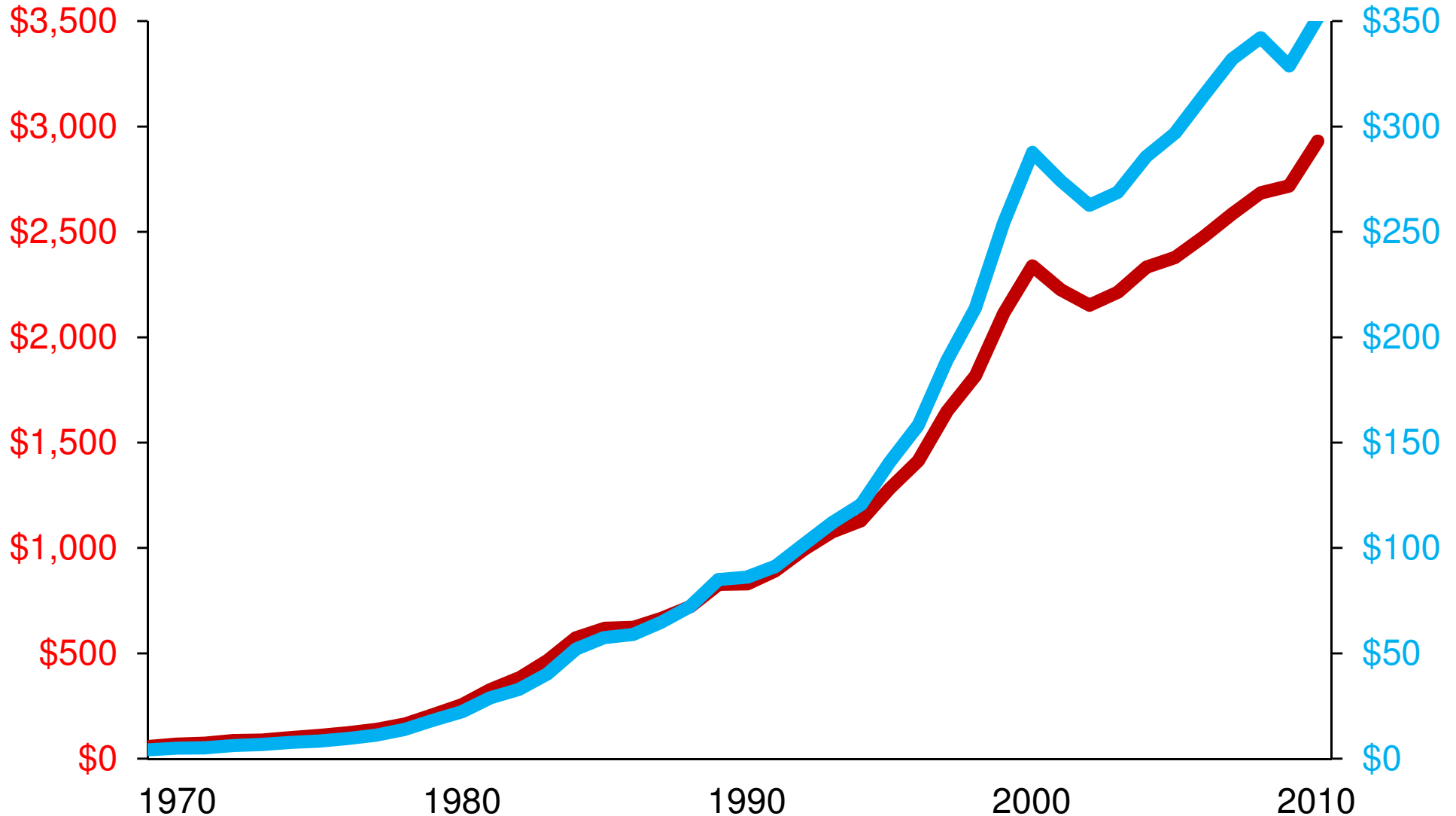

Investment (\$B)



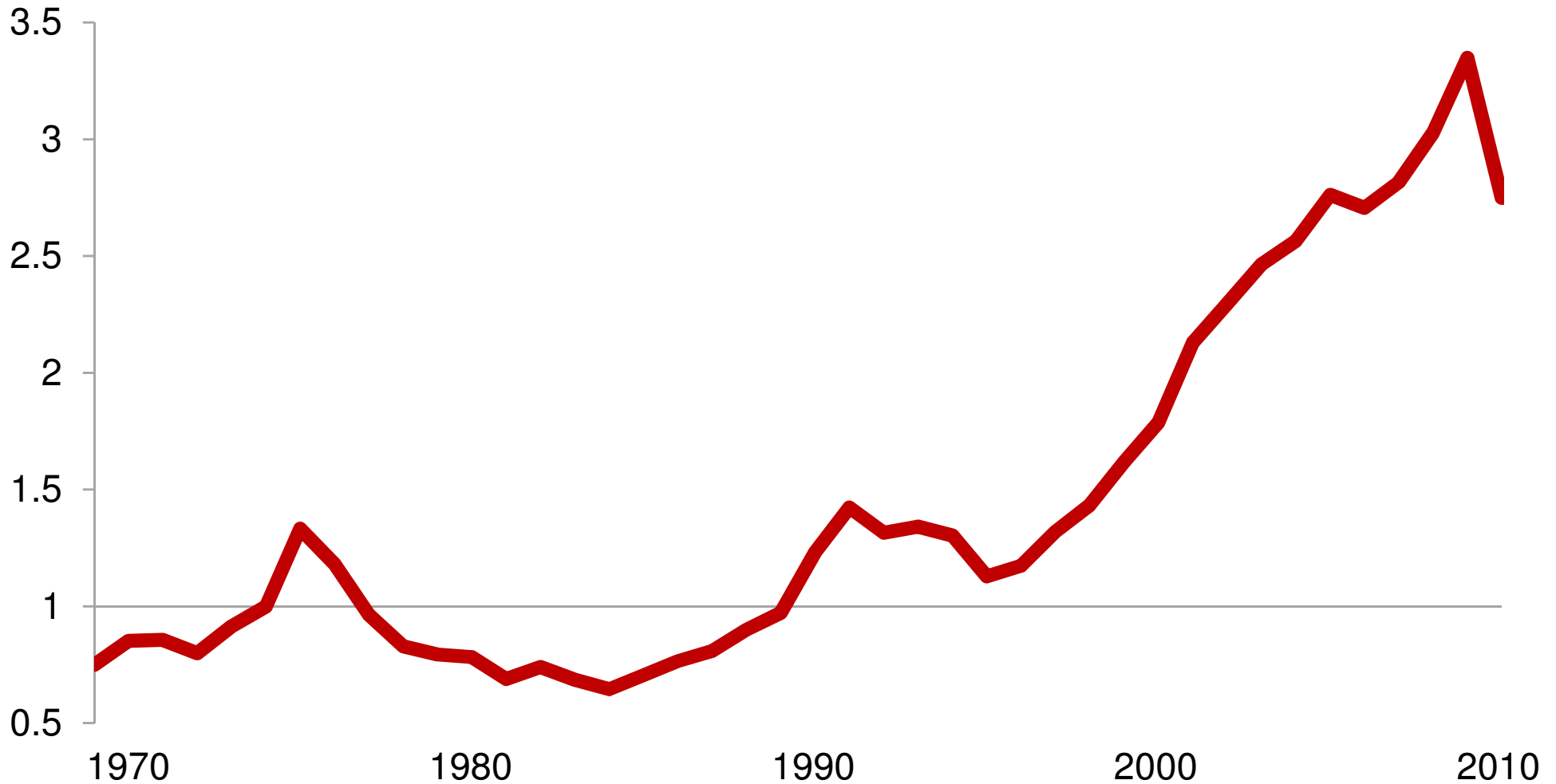

SW : HW Ratio



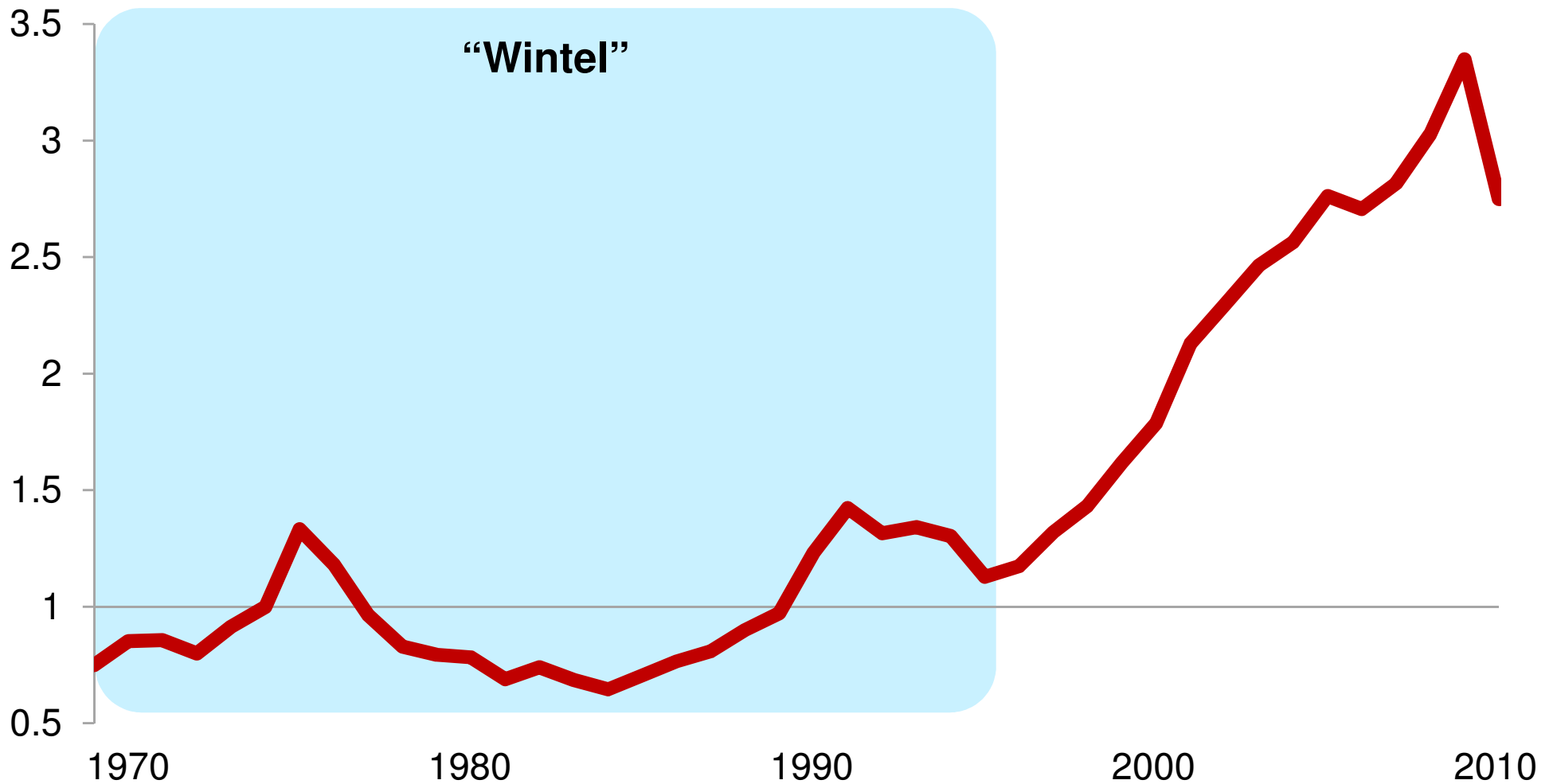

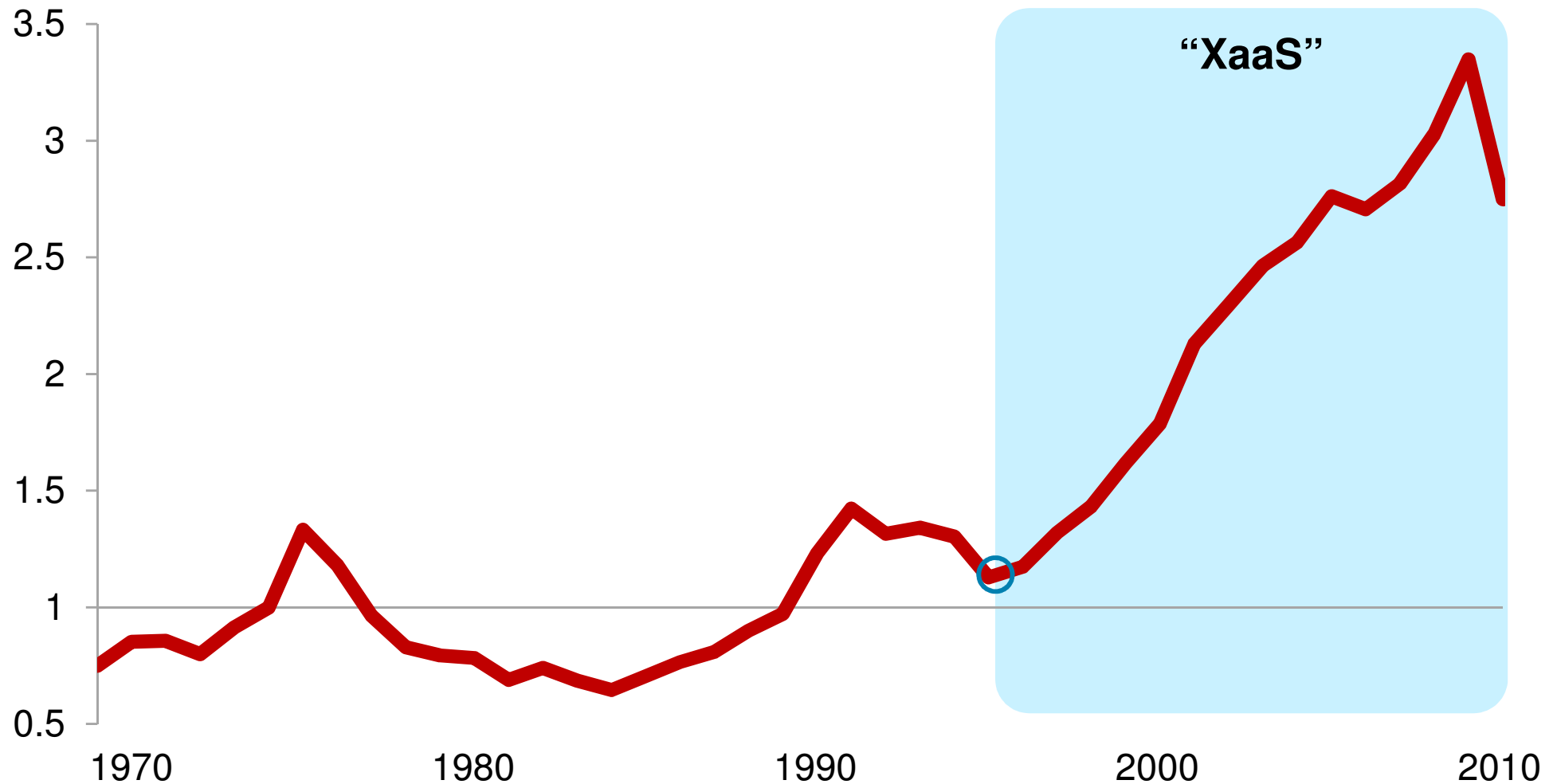

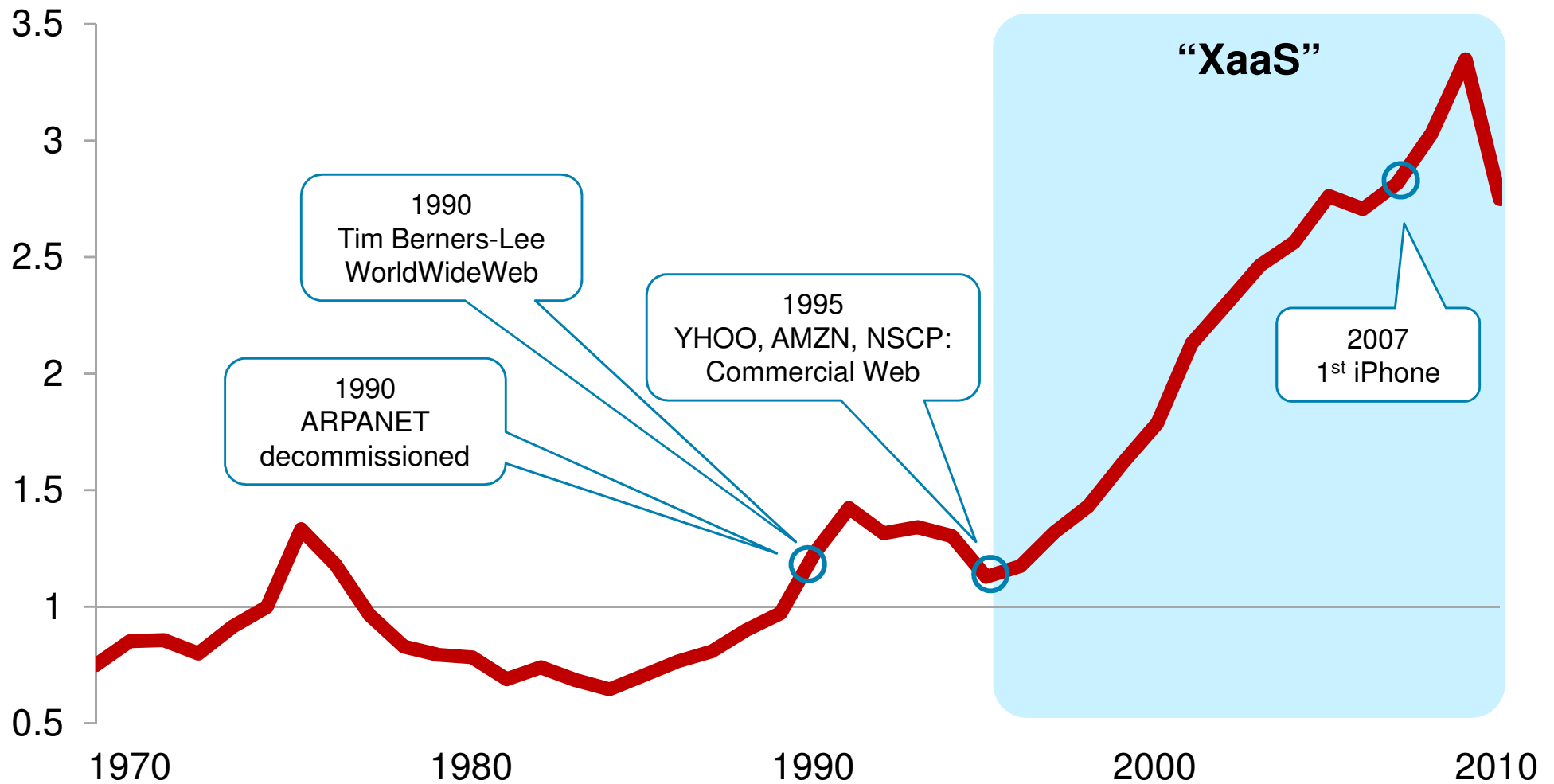

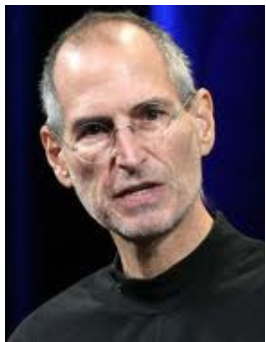

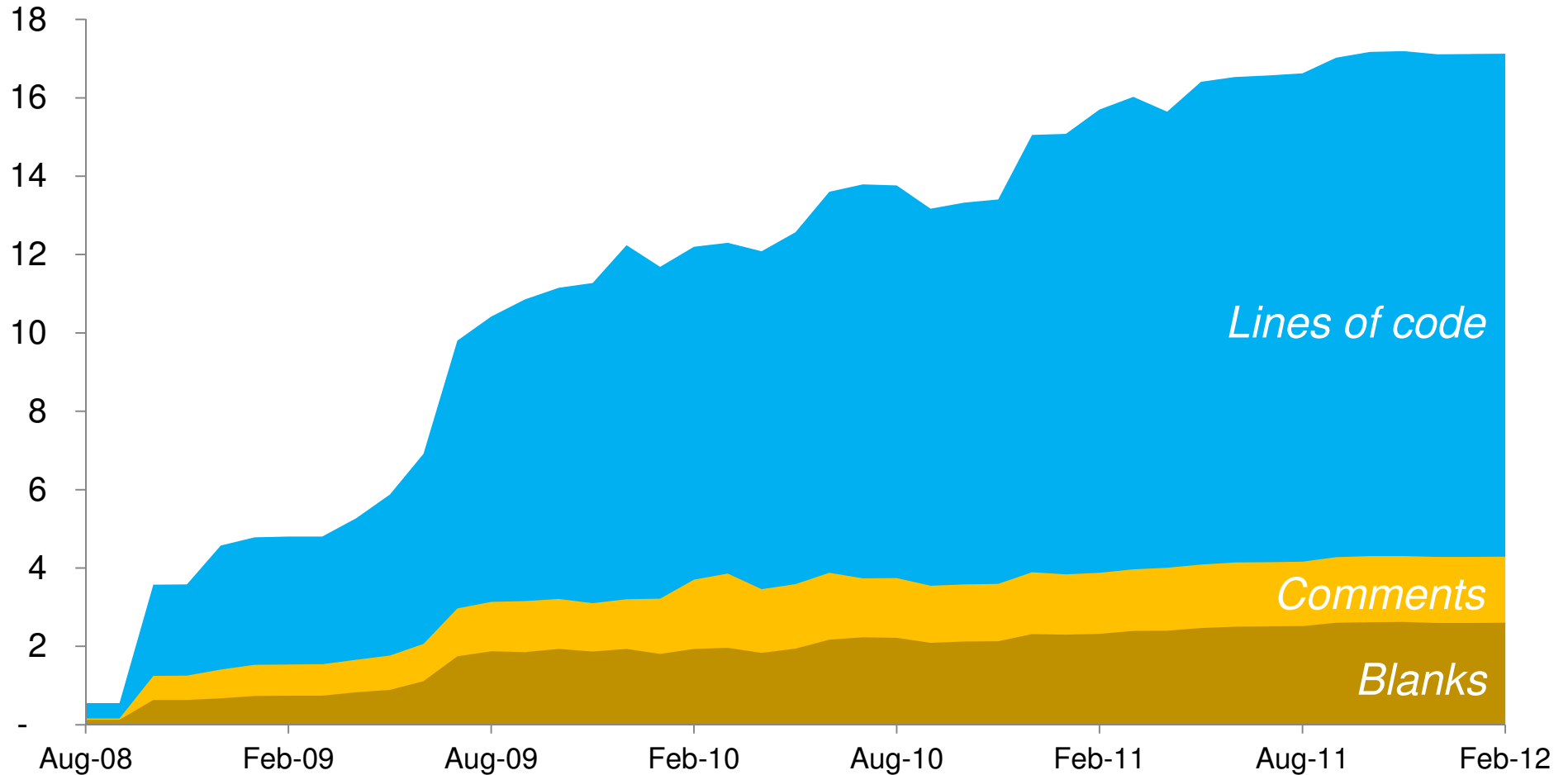

From 3.6M to 17.1M lines in the code base in 3.5 years

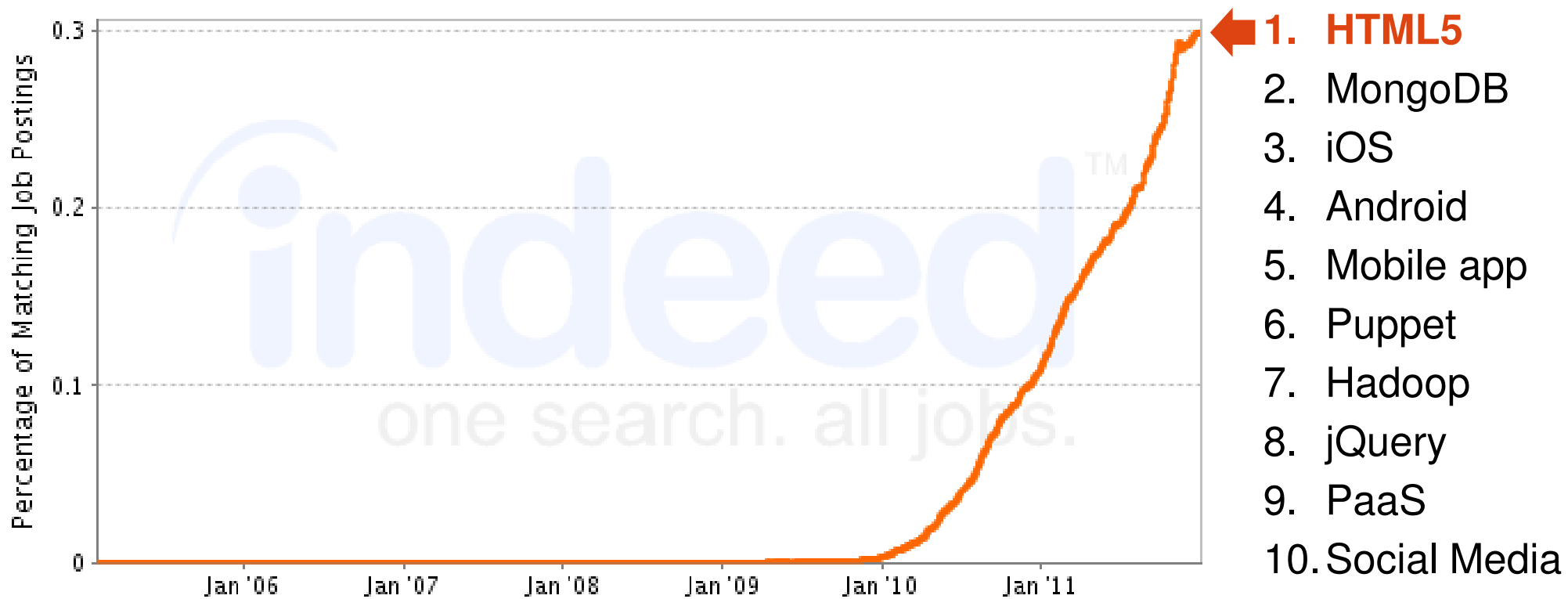

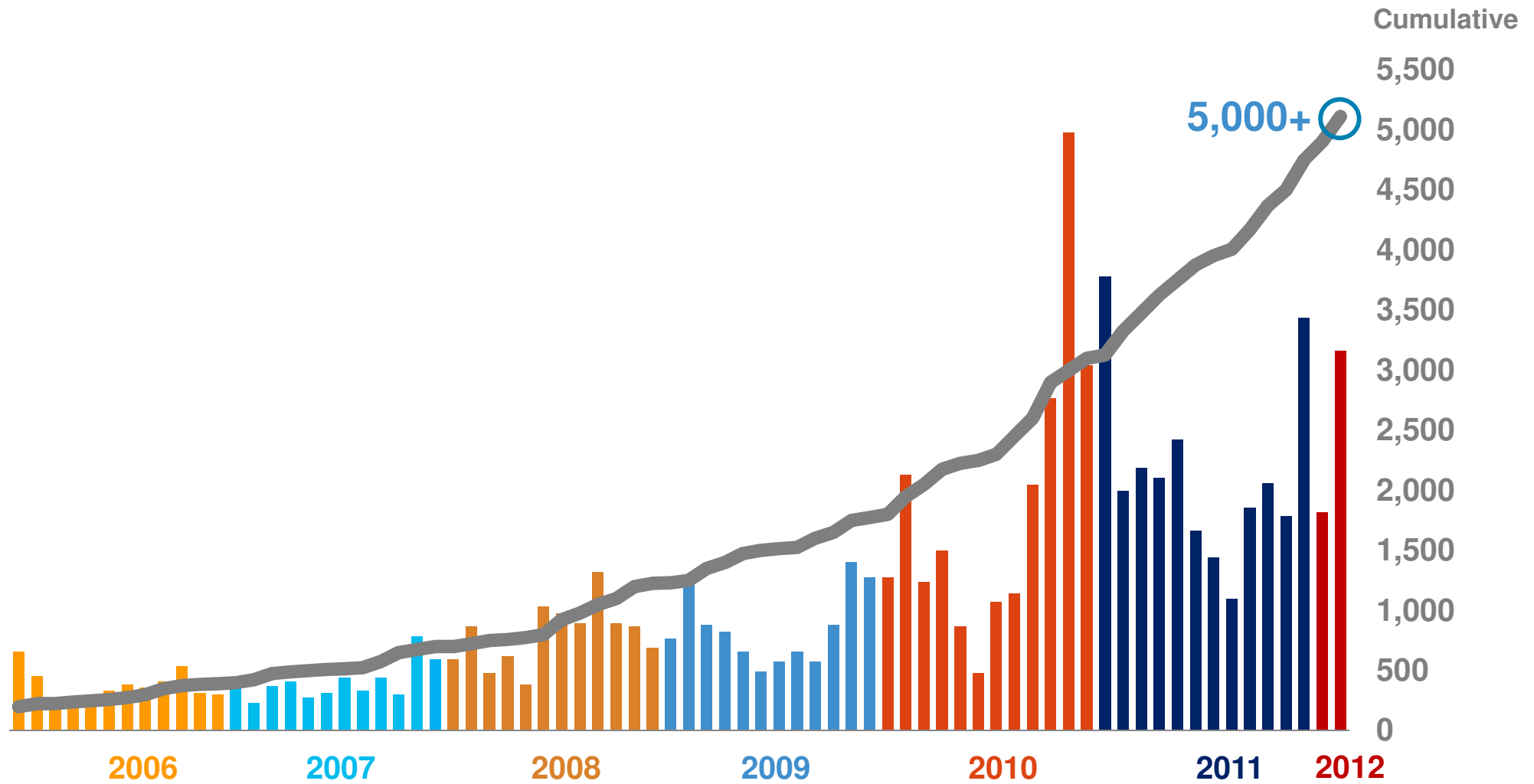

“Programmable Web”, number of published APIs per month, 2006-2011

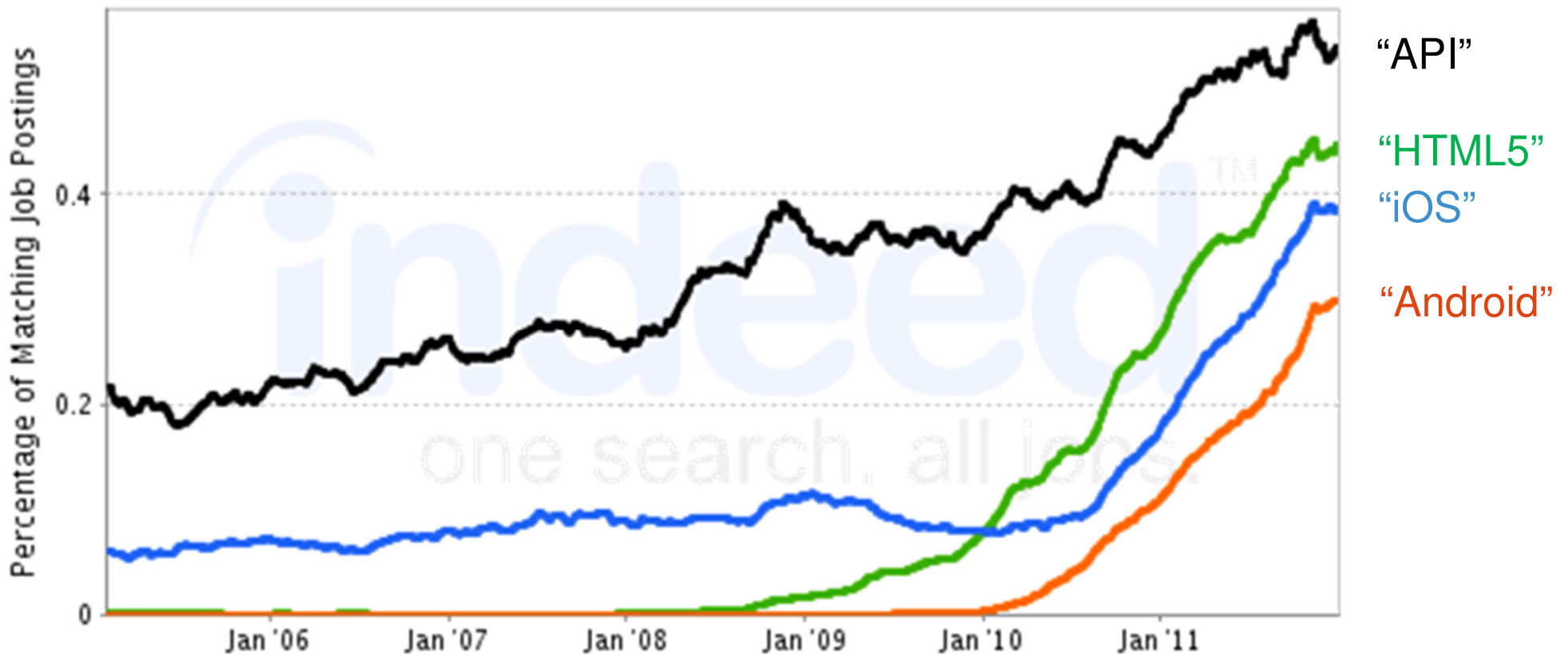

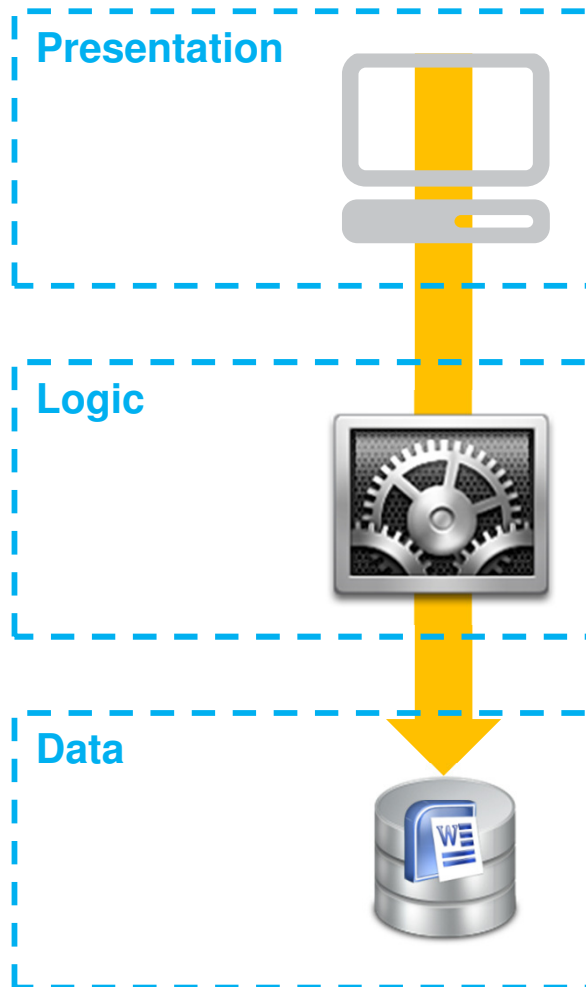

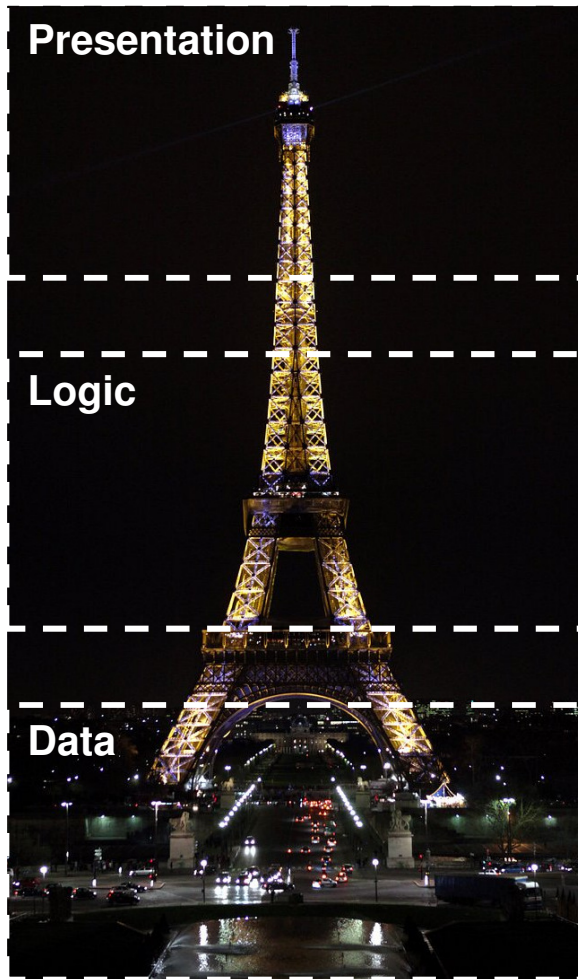

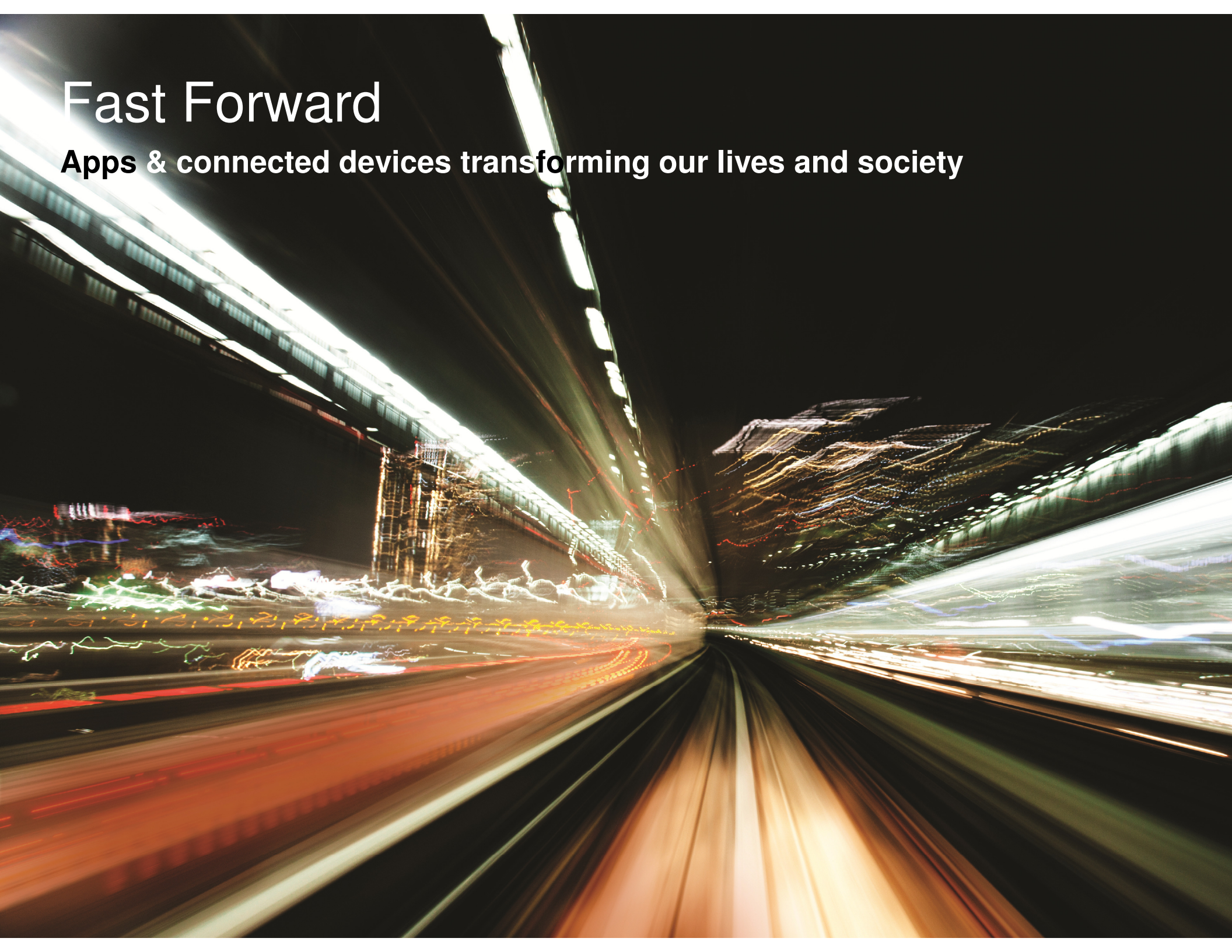

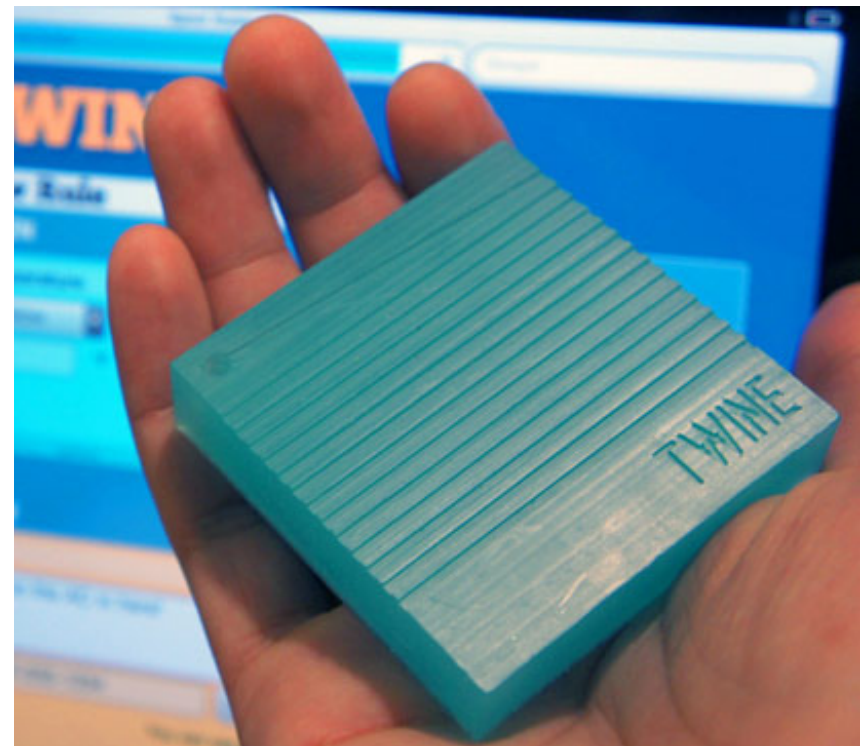

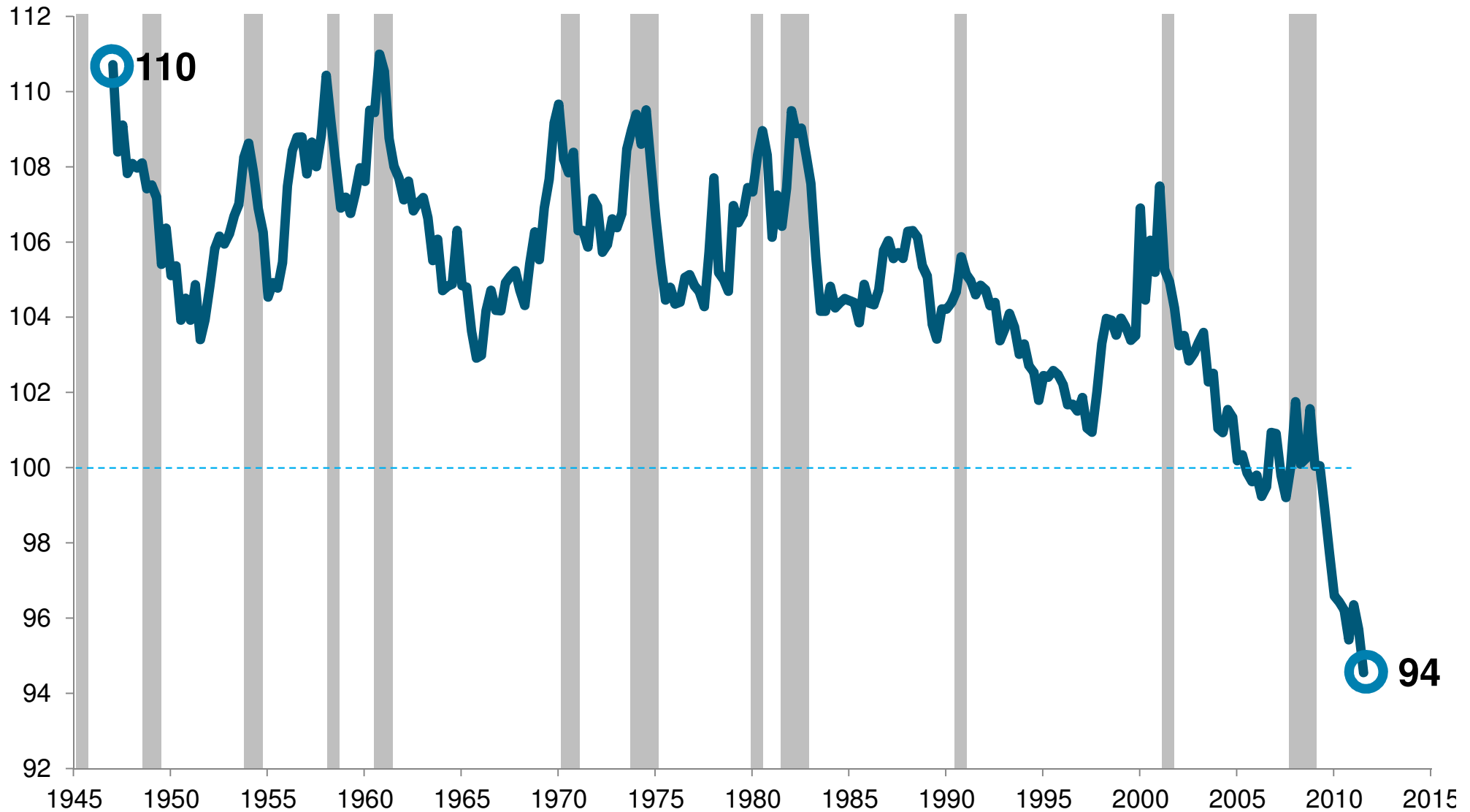
