11. Study Scheme

Coursework Requirement

Students are required to complete a minimum of 24 units (8 courses) for graduation. **One required course** and any **Seven elective courses** from the Four Areas prescribed in the course list with at least **TWO Areas** chosen from Area 1, 2 and 3. **Out of the 24 units, at least 18 units must be RELS-coded courses (applicable to students admitted in 2022-23 and thereafter).**

- Required course: RELS5005 Theories of Religious Studies
- Area 1 (Religion, Heritage and Context)
- Area 2 (Religion, Society and Culture)
- Area 3 (Religion, Life and Wisdom)
- Area 4 (Special Topics in Religious Studies)

• Other Requirements

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Students must take at least one course per term throughout the normative study period stipulated in the "General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies".
- Students must fulfill the Term Assessment Requirement of the Graduate School.
