The first part of this course is to build economic and financial theories to understand interest rates, exchanges rates, monetary theory, and central banking. The second part of this course is to apply the concepts learnt in the first part to investigate financial crisis and regulation. For example, we will discuss the Great Depression in 1930s, the Great Recession 2008-09. New concepts, such as zero lower bound and quantitative easing, will be discussed.
