Please submit your work (the signed front page and all complete answer sheets) in one electric file (PDF is better) online through Blackboard on or before the due time. You are kindly reminded to prepare your submission earlier than the due time. Late submission will not be accepted.
- 7. It is an open-book test. You are allowed to use the textbook, lecture notes, and any reference books. The test must be done by yourself without asking others in any format. Discussions amongst classmates are strictly prohibited.
