Announcement – BA/BSSc in Contemporary China Studies
(For Year 2 and above Students)

1. Online Add-Drop, 9 September (Mon) – 15 September (Sun)

Students should sit in on classes, study the course outline, and discuss with the course teacher before enrolling in a course. ***Dropping a course(s) after the Add-Drop period will not be approved*** except in very special circumstances and with clear justification. If problems arise, please contact the Programme Director as early as possible for guidance.

2. Final Course Register

It is the responsibility of every student to ***check his/her final course register once the Add-Drop period has ended.***

3. Chinese Language (Putonghua/Cantonese) Classes

On top of the 6 units of University Core Chinese (see below item 4) and the extra 6 units of Chinese language required by the Programme, students must complete another 9 units of Major required Chinese language classes (CPTH / CLCP / CLCE and/or CCAN / CLCC) to graduate. Altogether, ***21 units**** of Chinese language are required for the Major students throughout the study of the undergraduate degree. Chinese language courses are offered by the Chinese Language Center (CLC) located in the Leung Kau Kui Building. ***The CLC courses cannot be enrolled on CUSIS, therefore, please visit the CLC office for course placement and enrollment.***

Add consent and prior consultation with the Programme Director is required.

6. Exchange Studies for Year 2, Term 2

Year 2 Students will be placed in Peking University (PKU). For native Chinese speakers, nominations for exchange programme at SOAS or University of Westminster will be made based on the GPA merit. All of the exchange details will be announced in September.

Remark: Since the collaboration agreement with National Taiwan University (NTU) is expired in 2019, there will be no quota offered in Spring 2020.

7. Concentrations

To declare a concentration, students shall apply on CUSIS and submit the “Course Information for Declaration of Concentration/Stream” form to the Centre *in the final term of attendance*.

8. Research Course and Capstone Research Paper

Students *in the final year of attendance* are required to register a research method course as follows before working on the capstone research paper. Upon the successful completion of the research method course, students are required to register CCSS4520 Capstone Research Paper *in the final Spring term of attendance*.

Students who will be graduating in 2019-20 Term 2 or 2020-21 Term 1 are required to register a research method course in this Term 1 as follows.
