

Field Trip

- Date:** 5th February, 2017
Time: 09:30 – 15:30
Gathering Point: 09:00, outside Exit A of **University Station**
Alternatively, you could arrive at the pier at 09:20 directly.
Departure: 09:30 from Ma Liu Shui Ferry Pier No. 3
Returning: Around 15:30 at the Ma Liu Shui Ferry Pier No. 3

In this field trip we will visit Bluff Head (Wong Chuk Kok Tsui, 黃竹角咀) and Port Island (Chek Chau, 赤洲). Bluff Head is one of the oldest strata in Hong Kong, dated to the Devonian. It is highly deformed, and as such, has some interesting structure. We will hike around Bluff Head to have a detailed look at the geological structure. In the afternoon, we would be circling around the Port Island on the ferry. The Port Island is called Chek Chau in Chinese because of its redish colour, which is caused by the high iron content due to a major change in regional environment.

Things to prepare:

- **A warm jacket and proper shoes.** It may be windy and cold. We will hike along the Bluff Head area, and the terrain is rough and may be slippery.
- **Water.** You should bring enough water, since there would not be any places to buy water during the field trip. There are convenient stores near the MTR stations.
- **Camera.** There are some fascinating sights during the field trip
- **Seasickness Medicine.**
- **Lunch would be provided.** You could bring some snacks and extra food.
