FEE

Programme Fee <u>HK\$32,800</u> per person*

The fee includes: round-trip air tickets, fuel surcharges and airport taxes, local accommodation, local transportation, some meals, daily bottled Water, administration fee and TIC stamp duty (setting-off from Hong Kong only)

The fee does not include: self-paid meals, entry visas, vaccinations and related medicine, virus testing, quarantine fee etc.

Participants are required to apply for a Ugandan visa online. The visa fee (approximately USD50) is borne by the participant. Documentary proof and itinerary can be provided by the cooperating partner the to participants for visa application. Due to the epidemic, the Ugandan government may change the entry visa policy at any time. Participants must hold valid travel documents and visas, which must be valid for six months or more from the date of departure.

Participants are required to be vaccinated against yellow fever and other vaccinations, and take preventive medicines against malaria. make Participants must an appointment with the Travel Health Center of the Department of Health relevant vaccinations for and purchase of medicines.

Activity planning is involved so participants are required to attend <u>a</u> <u>pre-trip briefing and have regular</u> <u>meetings</u> before departure. Department of Health provides service of yellow fever vaccination. The daily consultation quota of the center is limited, please call the Travel Health Center to make an appointment for vaccinations after accepting offers.

If the participant cannot join this trip due to failure to get vaccinated, he/she will be required to pay full programme fee to the College

OBLIGATIONS OF STUDENTS

- Students should be cooperative and take initiative in liaising with the Dean of Students' Office, United College.
- Students are obliged to participate in official functions organized by the Dean of Students' Office and receiving NGO and organization, eg pre-trip briefing session, preparation meetings, review session, post-trip follow-up activities etc.
- Selected students are required to submit a learning journal & photos <u>OR</u> video clip upon the completion of programme for publication/future promotion of the programme.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

- Participants will be insured under the University's Group Travel Insurance package. He / She may consider taking out additional insurance as deemed appropriate.
- All selected students will shoulder their own direct expenses eg. visa application, vaccination, etc.
- The basic programme fee is HK\$32,800*. Upon Satisfactory completion of all requirements of the progamme, students will be eligible for consideration of the "GOAL Programme Non-local Service Learning



Scholarship" supported by the College Endowment Fund. The maximum amount per student is HK\$16,500.

• Participants with financial difficulties may apply for assistance from other departments/ units of the University.

REMARKS

A student will not be granted more than one award per year under the United GOAL Programme series, between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023, except those located in Mainland China and Taiwan.
