United College Xin Min Scholarship (2022-2023)

Aim of the Scholarship:

The United College Xin Min Scholarship will salute the UC student who has performed the best service for the benefit of the College and the community throughout his/her University study while at the same time demonstrating a capability for sustained academic advancement.

Value of the Scholarship:

The monetary value of the Scholarship is HK\$50,000. The recipient, however, will additionally be honoured with a public citation at the College's Anniversary Ceremony; a record of his/her accomplishments will be kept in the College archives.

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be a final-year student of United College.
2. Applicants must possess an excellent record for services to the College, the University and the community in general, as evidenced by certificates and testimonial letters issued by the relevant organizations; he/she must be capable of successfully combining extra-curricular pursuits with academic activities.
3. Applicants should have a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.0. Applicants with truly exceptional service and/ or extra-curricular records may be considered for an award with lesser GPA on an individual basis.
4. Applicants should contact either their Department Coordinators or the Dean of Students for nomination.

Selection:

Short-listed candidates will be interviewed by a special panel composed of College Fellows appointed for this purpose by the Scholarships and Student Finance Committee.

Application / Nomination:

Award of this Scholarship is not mandatory. If in a year the Selection Panel should decide that there are no worthy candidates, the scholarship may be withdrawn.
