Application Guidelines for Student Hostel Residence Grant 2022-2023

The Student Hostel Residence Grant Scheme provides financial support to needy students to enable them to have a residential College life for advancement in academic performance and for better participation in various activities on campus. This Scheme is supported by various donors.

Eligibility

To be eligible for Student Hostel Residence Grant in the 2022-23, you need to meet the following requirement:

- Applied for a hostel place in 2022-2023 on the University campus successfully (including hostels of College, I-house and hostels for medical students)
- Resided in hostel for at least 75% of the time of the term (based on the availability of the hostels for students)

Grant Amount

The amount of each grant for 2022-2023 will be HK\$1,360. For each applicant, a maximum of two grants may be allocated for the 1^{st} Term and 2^{nd} Term of the academic year. (i.e. HK\$1,360 x 2 = HK\$2,720)

Application Period

The application period for the 1st term / whole year Hostel Residence Grant is from 5 September to 12:00 noon of 30 September 2022 and that for the 2nd term is from 16 January to 12:00 noon of 3 February 2023. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Application Method

Students should submit application by <u>webform</u> in application period. Relevant documents should be uploaded together to the website as instructed. Incomplete forms and late applications will not be considered. Applicant will receive an application confirmation via email after completing the online application.

Application Result

Applicants will be informed of the results via CUHK @link email.
