Dr. Nichole C. Bass graduated from Zurich University in Switzerland with a Master degree (M.A.) in German Literature and Linguistics, Media Sciences and Social Psychology. She obtained her doctoral degree in German Linguistics from Zurich University in 2006. Before joining CUHK, Dr. Bass taught German as a Foreign Language in Zurich. Her research focuses on (i) phraseology, i. e. the study of fixed expressions, such as idioms, phrasal verbs, and other types of multi-word lexical units, (ii) media linguistics, and (iii) language acquisition.



Professor Letty Kwan (關於儀教授) received her Ph.D. from the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign and has served as Research Fellow in Nanyang Business School, Nanyang Technological University (南洋理工大學), Singapore and Assistant Professor at Sun Yat-sen Business School (中山大學管理學院) before joining CUHK. Trained as a social psychologist, her research goal is to integrate theoretical and empirical perspectives from different social sciences to deepen understanding of the cultural contexts in creative management, globalization, and moral decision making. She seeks to apply the insights learned from her research to provide solutions to everyday problems.

Professor Diana T.F. Lee (李子芬), College Fellow and Chairperson of General Education and Academic Affairs Committee, along with other nurse leaders from all over the world, will be inducted as a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing (FAAN) at its Annual Policy Conference in Washington, D.C. on 17th Oct.



Professor Lee has participated in a wide range of community services including chairing the Nursing Council of Hong Kong and being a member of the Hospital Authority Board and the Elderly Commission. She has initiated a number of health care and education projects that have had a cumulative impact on relevant policy and practice.

The American Academy of Nursing (AAN) is currently comprised of more than 2,300 nurse leaders in education, management, practice, policy and research from 25 countries including the United States, Australia and Canada. Academy fellows include hospital and government administrators, college deans and renowned scientific researchers. Fellow selection criteria include evidence of significant contributions to nursing and health care, and sponsorship by two current Academy fellows. Applicants are reviewed by a panel comprised of elected and appointed fellows, and selection is based, in part, on the extent the nominee's nursing career has influenced health policies and the health and wellbeing of all.
