1. Professional Learning Scheme in Shanghai 上海專業研習計劃



A group of 20 students set off to Shanghai on 22nd May and embraced dual experience of professional attachment and cultural exchange.



Participants experienced front-line operations and interacted with top management during their attachment at The Peninsula Shanghai (上海半島酒店), Hongrun Construction Group Company Limited (宏潤建設集團股份有限公司), Sand Bankcard-link Information and Service Company Limited (杉德銀卡通資訊服務有限公司), Tencent (騰訊公司), Mark Fairwhale (Shanghai) Commercial Company Limited (馬克華菲(上海)商業有限公司) and Shanghai Fortune Tech. Group (上海潤欣科技股份有限公司).



To immerse into the dynamic environment of Shanghai, we engaged Zhide College of Fudan University (復旦大學志德書院) for cultural exchange. The visit to Shanghai City Planning Museum and Yangshan Deep-Water Port aroused students' interest in the contemporary development of the city. At the same time, they also explored the history of Shanghai at seminars in Fudan University and visit at Shanghai Jewish Refugees Museum. The exploration provoked students of both colleges to discuss and share the

similarities and differences of Hong Kong and Shanghai, hence presented their views to mark the finale of the programme.

The 18-day journey highlighted the significance of people skills, self-initiative and business insights for students. The personal network and friendship established will both be their valuable treasures as well as happy memories.

2. Suzhou Internship cum Cultural Exchange Program 蘇州科技園實習計劃暨文化交流



Gaining a new experience this summer, five College students are currently having their internship program in Suzhou Land High Tech System Technology Co., Ltd. (蘇州藍海彤翔系統科技有限公司).



Before earning hands-on experience in the company, the participants took part in a one-week cultural exposure hosted by students of C.W. Chu College of Soochow University (蘇州大學敬文書院) to become familiar with the ancient and modern Suzhou. More than visiting the scenic gardens designated as UNESCO World Heritage Sites such as the Humble Administrator's Garden (拙政園) and historic pagodas, students learnt about the recent rapid development of the city via their provoking conversation with young local entrepreneurs and the visit to the Suzhou Industrial Park Planning Exhibition Hall (蘇州工業園規劃展示館).



The integration of the olds and news in Suzhou is promising. Students are not only amazed by the success of conservation work but also inspired by the talk conducted by the leading teacher Professor Hui, LIN (林琿教授), Director of Institute of Space & Earth Information Science (太空與地球信息科學研究所). A prestigious scholarship for pursuing a postgraduate degree or a second bachelor's degree at the University of Oxford, U.K. commencing October 2017 is now open for application. The basic tenure of the Scholarship is two years, subject to satisfactory academic performance and personal conduct. At the discretion of the Trustees, the Scholarship may be extended for a third year for those who take a recognized route to the DPhil. A Rhodes Scholarship covers all University and College fees, a personal stipend and one economy class airfare to and from the United Kingdom.

CUHK Golden Jubilee Celestial Civilian Scholarship on Hong Kong Literature aims to encourage and recognize the excellence of research, analysis, and writing by the students of CUHK in the use of primary sources and rare materials held by the Hong Kong Literature Collection of University Library System (ULS). Number and Value of Scholarship

There will be two scholarships of HK\$10,000 each. The scholarship recipients should be able to demonstrate their strong competence in using the Hong Kong Literature Collection for their outstanding research papers on Hong Kong literature and related fields. No award will be granted if there is no suitable candidate.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be full-time students taking undergraduate / research postgraduate programmes;
- submit a research paper / thesis / dissertation, written in either English or Chinese, on Hong Kong literature and related fields;
- submit a statement in 500-800 words, written in either English or Chinese, on how to make use of the Hong Kong Literature Collection for the research paper / thesis / dissertation.

5. Sustainable Development Promotion Award for Students of Higher Education Institutions (SDPA) 高等院校學生推動可持續發展獎

The SDPA is a new initiative launched in 2016 for students of higher education institutions. It aims to promote the concept of sustainable development (SD) to the students of higher education institutions in Hong Kong and raise their awareness of the importance of SD; and to encourage them to apply sustainable practices in their daily lives and spread the messages to their peers, families and the community.

Undergraduate students are encouraged to devise and implement projects which can apply the concept of SD in their daily lives and spread the message to the community. Awards would be given to outstanding proposals and projects that best meet the aim. The competition consists of two phases:

(I) Proposal Phase - submission of project proposals

(II) Implementation Phase - implementation of the projects receiving awards in the Proposal Phase

The best five proposals in the Proposal Phase will be given the Proposal Award which will comprise a cash prize of \$3,000 and a certificate. All winners in the Proposal Phase are expected to proceed to implement their projects in the Implementation Phase. All entrants of Implementation Phase meeting the conditions as set out in the rules of competition will be given the Implementation Award with another cash prize of \$7,000 and certificate. The entrant which performs the best among the Implementation Award winners will be given the Outstanding Project Award with another cash prize of \$10,000 and certificate.
