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1. A Memorable Day - The College 1st Graduation Ceremony marks successful conclusion



On 17<sup>th</sup> November 2016, more than 150 graduates and their family members attended the College Graduation Ceremony. As the 1<sup>st</sup> Graduation Ceremony in the history of Wu Yee Sun College, the day was to embrace joy and success, not only for the graduates and their families, but also for the guests and friends of the College.



Joined with more than 50 college members and guests, the graduation day kicked off with a simple ceremony unveiling the graduates plaque in the Central Courtyard by College Overseers, Mr. Albert Wu (伍步昌先生) and Mr. Arthur Wu (伍尚宗先生), together with College Master, Professor Rance P.L. Lee (李沛良教授) and the College graduate cum representative of the College Alumni Association Preparatory Committee, Mr. Sam L.H. Cheung (張力行先生). The plaque engraving the names of all the graduates commemorates the achievement of our college students.



The ceremony began with the procession making their way to the ceremonial ground, followed with an opening address by Professor Lee, who welcomed the guests and praised the students for their accomplishment. Overseeing his first Graduation Ceremony in his capacity as the College Master, Professor Lee encouraged our graduates to pursue their dreams with passion and perseverance, and always go the extra mile to get a work done without seeking a return.

Professor Lee then invited the Guest of Honor, Mr. Stanley H.C. Hui, JP (許漢忠太平紳士), Deputy CEO of NWS Holdings Limited, to give a speech to the audience. Mr. Hui reminded our graduates to reflect constantly on what they have learned at Wu Yee Sun College and to think about what they could contribute to the common good of Hong Kong as well as the country apart from building a successful career for themselves.



Following the addresses, the students were invited to receive their certificates and graduation souvenirs. The ceremony then concluded with a valedictorian speech from our student speaker, Mr. Sam L.H. Cheung, who spoke about the college's achievement in the past four years, and the challenges ahead as the graduates move onto the next stage of their life.



## 2. HSBC Overseas Scholarship 2017/18 Now Open for Application

The scholarship will enable local **non-final year full-time undergraduate** students to spend **a semester or an academic year** as a visiting student or an exchange student at one of the overseas universities selected from the List of Overseas Universities. The maximum total value for each scholarship is HK\$300,000, which can only go towards tuition fees and mandatory college fees, a minimum economy return airfare, reasonable room and board costs, books, a small portion of living expenses and visa application fees.

#### 3. Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme 2017

The Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme (the Scheme) aims to provide recognition to outstanding undergraduates in universities in Hong Kong as well as opportunities to widen their international/Mainland exposure and gain industry experience. Twenty-five science undergraduates, to be nominated by the six local universities and selected by an Awardee Selection Committee of the Scheme, will each be awarded a scholarship of up to HK\$150,000. The Scheme comprises the following components:

- (a) Financial support for Overseas/Mainland Attachment Programme(s) between 1 June 2017 and 30 June 2018 (at least one of the attachment programmes must be longer than three weeks)
- (b) Mentorship Programme
- (c) Service Project Programme
- (d) Local Internship Programme (optional)

## **Eligibility and Selection Criteria**

The Scheme is open to **full-time**, **non-final-year undergraduates** who meet the following criteria:

- Undertaking a science-related degree funded by the University Grans Committee (UGC). In general they cover (i) Sciences; (ii) Engineering and Technology; and (iii) Medicine, Dentistry and Health.
- Preferably cumulative GPA of 3.3 (or equivalent) or above up to Term 1 of 2016/17.
- A minimum total TOEFL (Internet-based test) score of 90 with scores for individual sections not lower than 21 on reading, 22 on listening, 21 on speaking, and 17 on writing; or a minimum IELTS (Academic Test) overall band score of 6.5, with no component below 6.0. All tests must have been taken on or after 11 February 2015.
