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## Sunny Review

### 1. Chow Tai Fook Service-Learning Programme: Service-Learning Trip to Sri Lanka





The College and The National Council of YMCAs of Sri Lanka organized the Chow Tai Fook Service-learning Programme: Service-learning Trip to Sri Lanka from 18<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> July. 17 College students of different backgrounds joined hands to serve the local community in Kilinochchi, located in northern Sri Lanka.

After months of preparation and with the help from local volunteers, the Sunnies provided service to children, widows and elderly affected by the civil war in the past few decades. Through a variety of games and simple classes, our students aimed to enhance the local children’s knowledge on health and English, and inspire them to enjoy happiness in their daily life. They also visited the elderly to teach them ways to lead a healthy life style and made memory books with them. The widows learnt basic first aid knowledge and tried new recipes with fresh fruit under the guidance of the Sunnies, and designed their own bags with colourful dyes. The Sunnies also paid a visit to an orphanage and had funny handicrafts and a game of cricket with the orphans, which is one of the most popular sports in Sri Lanka.

Under the arrangement of the National General Secretary of YMCA Sri Lanka, the delegation had the chance to visit the Port City in Colombo, which is one of the major projects of The Belt and Road Initiative. They also interacted with local secondary teachers and students regarding the Initiative during the visit to St. John’s College in Jaffna, a college established for 195 years. One of the Sunnies, who is an international student from Tajikistan, shared his preparation and challenges when studying abroad in Hong Kong.

After concluding the 11-day trip, participants had to chance to reflect on war and peace, and had deeper understanding on The Belt and Road Initiative.



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## 2. Peking University Summer School International 2018



3 Sunnies had been chosen to join Peking University Summer School International from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> July and attended various courses on Peking University campus. Some took a course on The Belt and Road Initiative with several field trips to visit the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank, Silk Road Fund, Center for China and Globalization and even attended the Belt and Road Global Youth Leaders Summit 2018.

Apart from attending courses, participants also enjoyed extra-curricular and social events such as learning Tai Chi, attending cooking classes and visiting the Great Wall to explore Chinese culture and history as well as to meet new friends from all over the world.

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### 2. The Esther Yewpick Lee Millennium Scholarship 2019 - Now Open for Application

#### **The Fund**

The Scholarships, tenable at the University of Oxford, are established with funds from the estate of the late Dr. Esther Yewpick Lee, whose family has had strong connections with and affection for both The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) and the University of Oxford.

#### **The Scholarship**



**One Scholarship for two to three years will be awarded to a degree graduate or final-year student of CUHK.**

Scholars may read for the Oxford BA in any of the final honour schools, or, if qualified by previous training, may be admitted to read for the advanced degrees of BCL, MLitt, MSc, MSt, MTh, MPhil or DPhil. Candidates should seek advice from their professors or academic tutors on the choice of study programme at Oxford before submitting their scholarship application. Candidates are strongly advised to apply for programmes of at least two years' duration in order to get the most benefit of studying at Oxford.

**Value of the Scholarship**

All amounts due in respect of University and College fees at Oxford, exclusive of board and lodging, will be paid direct to the College concerned. The Scholar will be provided with a return economy class air fare between Hong Kong and London, charges for land transportation between London and Oxford, and an annual personal allowance which is expected to take care of board and lodging and other maintenance costs. Tenure of other awards in conjunction with this Scholarship is not permitted without the consent of CUHK.

**Eligibility**

- Applicants should be either final-year students in the academic year 2018/19 including both undergraduates and postgraduates of degree programmes, or graduates holding degrees awarded by CUHK.
- Successful candidates must have outstanding academic records and have a respect for humanity, a curious mind, moral integrity and a spirit of adventure and reveal the potential to make a contribution to the well-being of the community.
- Candidates must be under 25 years of age on 1 October 2019.
