The first College Roundtable Dinner was held on 18th January in College Staff Canteen. We were grateful to have Prof. Anthony T.C. Chan (陳德章教授), College Master, and Dr. Jose S.H. Lai (賴陳秀卿博士), Chairperson of Service-Learning Committee, hosting the Dinner. Prof. Chan encouraged students to participate in diverse College activities, and wish students could cherish and enjoy their College life. Dr. Lai then shared her own study

experience with students and hope students could persevere when facing adversity, at the same time could find the way to relieve study pressure.

The first College Forum of this semester, entitled 'The Joy and Sadness on the Way of Chasing Dreams 追夢路上 的樂與悲' was conducted by Mr. Chan Hiu Ming (陳曉明先生), Head Coach of Lee Man Football Club, on 20th January. Mr. Chan shared with students about his journey of becoming a football coach, as well as his attitude in the face of setbacks. He believed one day the efforts will eventually be recognized as long as keep trying and improving. He also encouraged students to learn from failure.

We were grateful to have Prof. Ming-Kay Poon (潘銘基教授), College Associate Master and Dean of General Education, for moderating the Forum.

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Music and art creation provide a great way for students to relieve stress and soothe their mind. A group of Sunnies joined the Kalimba Making Workshop on 16 Jan to create their own unique Kalimba! They firstly drew patterns on the Kalimba wood with full concentration. Then, they inserted the keys into the Kalimba wood with a little hammer one by one skillfully and patiently. Finally, the instructor taught them to read the music sheet and play several

songs. After creating the kalimba, a portable and easy-to-play music instrument, students can enjoy playing it whenever they feel upset or depressed to improve their well-being.

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20 students have joined DIY Maneki-neko & Entrepreneurship Sharing Workshop organized by Clab entrepreneurship stream on 17 January to learn about the startup experience from Youtuber 'Baby Shadow'. While the sharing, students and the guest speaker designed their own Maneki-neko (Lucky Cat) together for good fortune in the coming year. Students have gained better understanding on the difficulties to initiate a startup business, and the possibilities to explore their career, as well as leveraging their creativity to design a lucky cat.





1. University of British Columbia Vancouver Summer Program (VSP) 2023

The **UBC Vancouver Summer Program (VSP)** is an opportunity for undergraduate students to study at the University of British Columbia in Summer 2023. It is a four-week, academic but non-credit, residential program at UBC. The VSP is not an internship program nor a practicum experience but rather two courses in which, depending on the course package, students may do a number of activities related to their program including attending workshops, doing cases, simulations, or labs or doing site visits.

VSP 2023 offers two four-week programs:

June Session: June 2 – July 2, 2023 Application deadline: February 18, 2023

July Session: July 14 – August 14, 2023 Application deadline: April 1, 2023

Our June – July and July – August sessions will be an in-person program and the <u>program cost</u> will be \$5,625 CAD per student for 2023. Students will need to arrange their own airfares here and bring additional funds for meals and personal spending such as optional tours.

There are over 70 <u>course packages</u> in a range of disciplines. Please note not all packages are available in both sessions so please review the 2023 options carefully.



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7. Multicultural Counselling Service for Non-local Students
