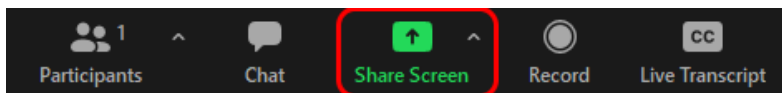


Using the ceiling camera

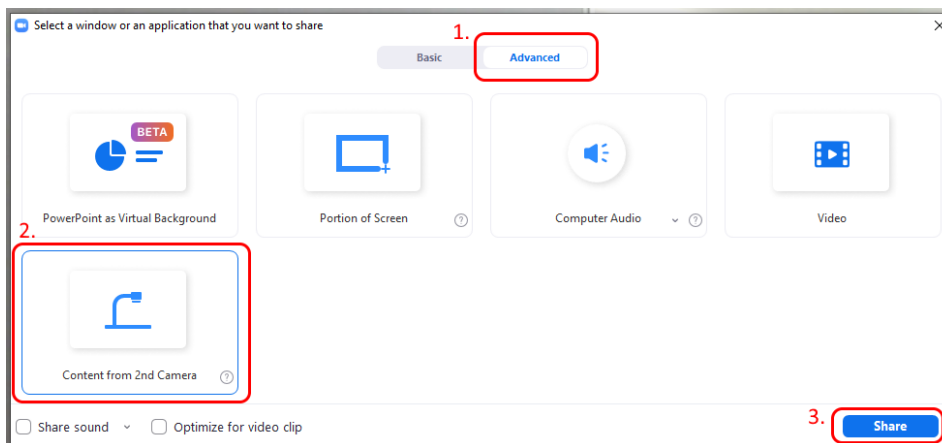
You can use the ceiling camera installed in specific classrooms to share physical content (e.g. words and drawings written on the whiteboard) to your audiences in a Zoom meeting.



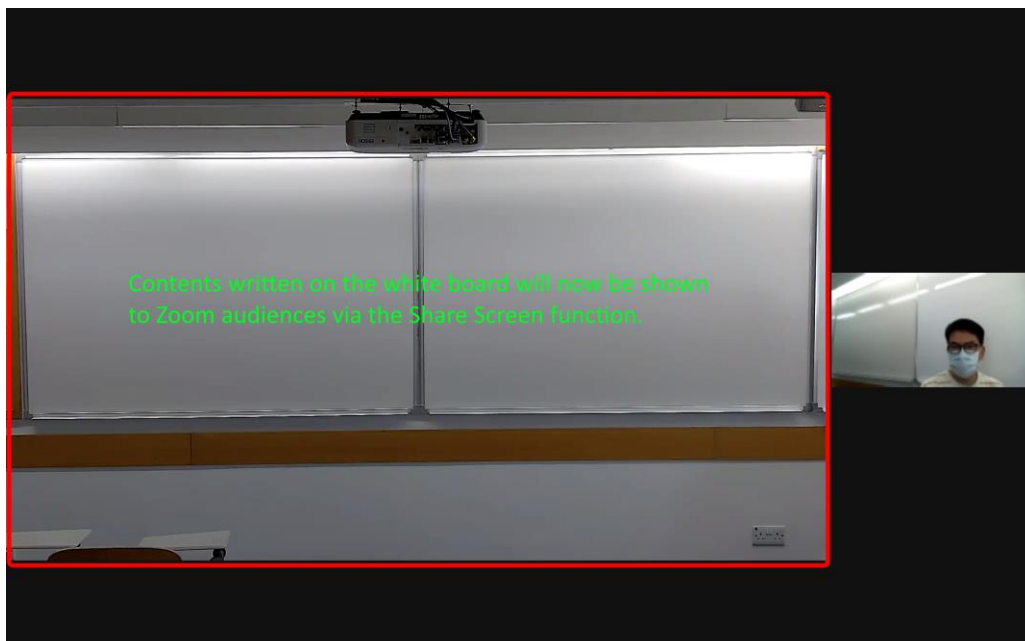
1. In a Zoom Meeting, click 'Share Screen'.







2. Click the 'Advanced' tab, then click 'Content from 2nd Camera', and then click 'Share'.



3. Your Zoom audiences will now see the image of the ceiling camera. By default, it will frame the center of the whiteboard.



4. Use the 'Zoom buttons' and 'Arrow buttons' to zoom in/out and pan to specific area.

5. Press '0' on the remote control to return the camera to the default position.



6. To stop sharing the camera, click the 'Stop Share' button.
