Starting from 21 November 2021, the Physical Education Unit (PEU) of CUHK will accept the application from alumni and qualified retired staff for using the sports facilities on Sundays or public holidays.

Eligible alumni and retired staff should note the following when using of university sports facilities:

- 1) CU alumni (and their spouse and children aged 18 or below) must hold the 'CU Alumni Credit Card' and have the alumni ID number
- 2) All retired staff (and their spouse and children aged 18 or below) with the 'certificate of ten years of service' issued by the Human Resources Office
- 3) The following facilities will be available for the use of the above-mentioned users and booking fees will be collected:

The basketball and badminton courts of Yeung Ming Biu Indoor Sports Centre, CU Tennis Courts 3 to 5, squash courts, HCF mini-soccer pitch field (each), running track, University Fitness Room.

The above-mentioned qualified users must comply with the epidemic prevention measures of PEU when using the sports facilities:

- 1) Body temperature screening will be arranged at the entrance. Users should have the body temperature screening before entering outdoor sports facilities. Masks must be worn before and after exercise. The spectator stand will be closed and the borrowing of sports equipment will be suspended.
- 2) To tie in with the epidemic prevention measures set by CUHK Emergency Response Group, users must complete two doses of vaccination or present negative result proof of a PCR-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 conducted within 14 days.
