#### **Chinese Medicine, Year 6 Student**

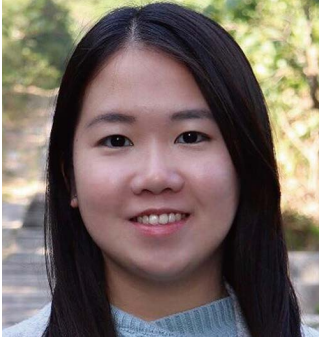
