**Dr. Hamen Fan Shi Hoo Residents' Work Scheme**

Regulations

Dr. Hamen Fan Shi Hoo generously donated a sum of HK\$1,000,000 to Lee Woo Sing College in 2014. The donation has been used to set up an endowment fund for full-time local or non-local residential students.

Regulations governing the award of the work scheme are detailed below:

**1. Name of the Work Scheme**

The work scheme will be named “Hamen Fan Shi Hoo Residents' Work Scheme” and in Chinese 「范思浩宿生工讀計劃」.

**2. Number and Value**

Each year there will be 20-40 awards of work scheme (HK\$1,000 – 2,000 each) with a total amount of HK\$40,000.

**3. Selection Criteria**

To be eligible for the Work Scheme, candidates should:

- be full-time local or non-local residential students affiliated to Lee Woo Sing College.

**4. Administrative Procedures**

- The Work Scheme is open for year round application.
- The awardees may need to meet with the donor to share their learning experiences at CUHK.
- The Work Scheme will be administered by the College Office of Lee Woo Sing College in accordance with the above regulations.

**5. Remarks**

Scholarships and Bursaries Committee of the College has discretion to slightly adjust the number of awards according to the quality of candidates and available fund.
