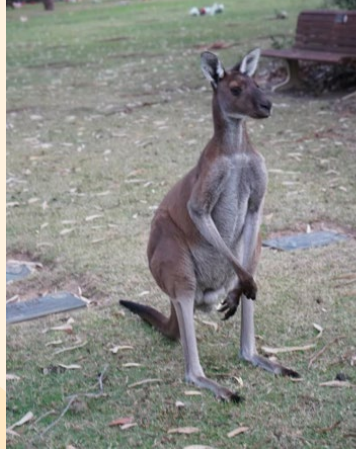

- 修水縣是江西省九江市下轄縣，位於贛西北。整體地形「八山半水一分田，半分道路和莊園」。歷史悠久，自古稱“文章奧府”，為“濂溪弦鐸之地，山谷桑梓之鄉”。文化底蘊豐富，歷代共辦書院25所，私塾不計其數，培養出黃庭堅、陳三立等文學大家。具有光明革命傳統，是秋收起義主要策源地、第一支工農革命軍發源地；茶業、桑蠶業發達，有雙井茶、黃龍茶、寧紅茶等名茶品牌。

- 新疆維吾爾自治區是中華人民共和國西北部的一個自治區，也是中國陸地面積第一大的省級行政區。自治區由新疆省改置，成立於 1955 年，首府位於烏魯木齊。新疆是維吾爾族、漢族、哈薩克族、回族、柯爾克孜族、蒙古族、錫伯族、塔吉克族、東鄉族等 19 個民族世代居住的地方，新疆維吾爾自治區現轄 4 個地級市、5 個地區、5 個自治州。
