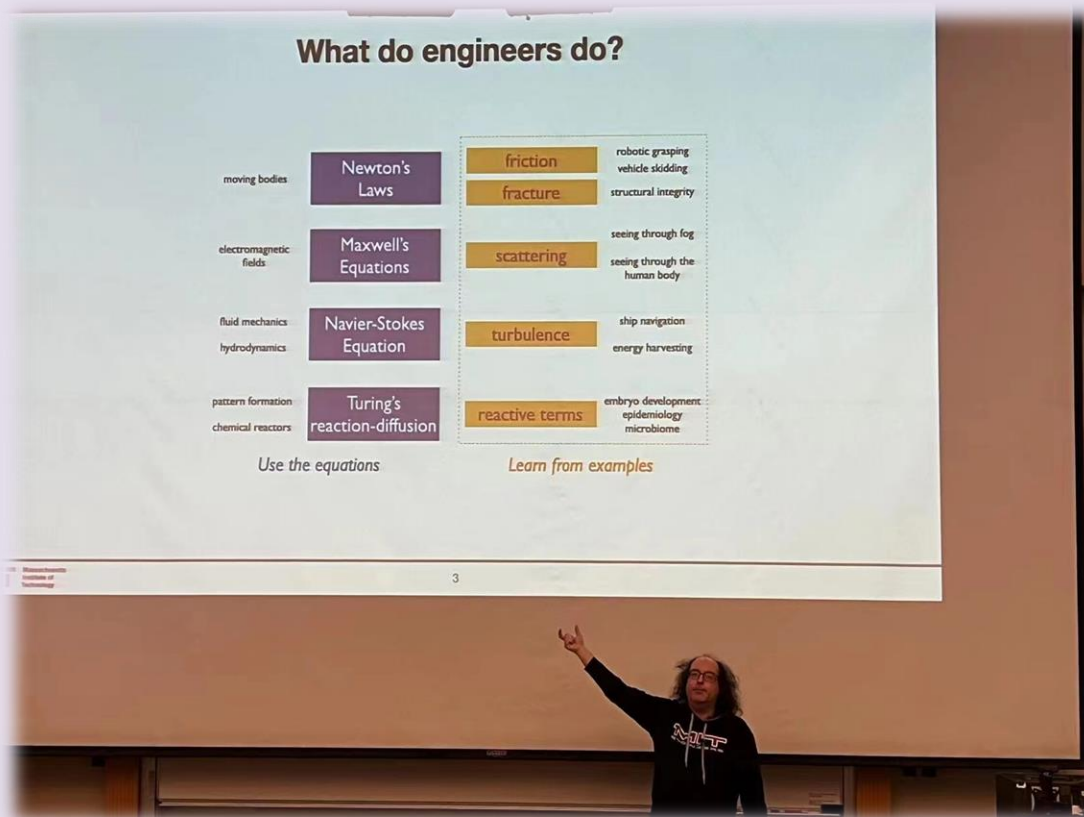

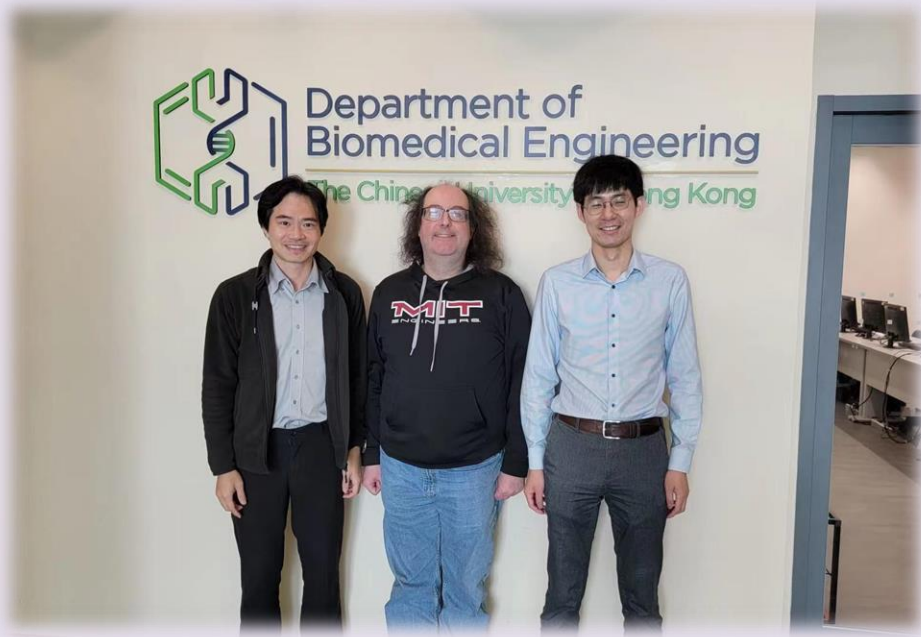
*“Machine Learning:

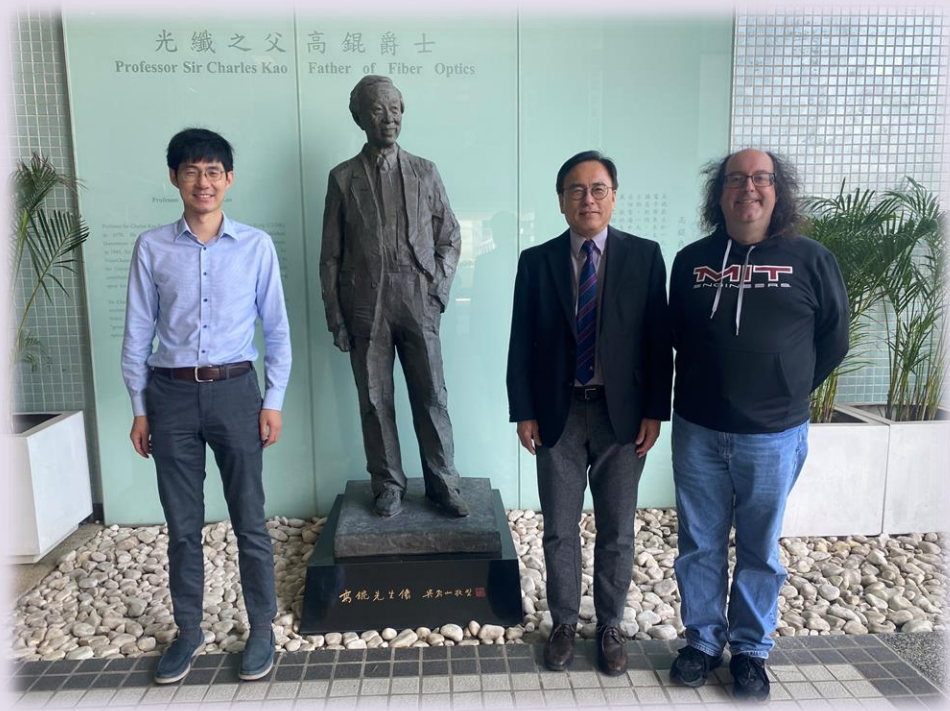
Our department invited Prof. George Barbastathis from Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) to visit and deliver a Faculty of Engineering Distinguished Lecture on **“Machine Learning: what’s in it for the physical sciences and engineering?”** on 6 March 2023.
