In 2018-2019, the PI will incorporate the videos into 4 to 5 lectures to run flipped classrooms to test how students react to this mode of teaching. Using deaf signing persons to present the information in Hong Kong Sign Language is an innovative idea and the PI will collect students' feedback on this mode of presentation. The PI will incorporate other activities like debates, guest lectures, inviting the deaf presenters to join the classroom discussions, hopefully to engage the students more in learning and to help them approach the topics analytically. There will be papers to read for the lectures, and questions will be prepared so students will continue to develop their arguments in the preparation of the term paper. This is the possibility of using UReply to create more opportunities for continued discussions on the questions set for the readings.
