Programme Structure

The programme is based on a hybrid mode of learning consisting of face-to-face teaching and experiential group work along with various online tasks and activities.



Facilitating Career Development: The Understanding Phase

職涯發展(II):知己知彼 (16 hours)

This covers key areas, practices, and tools for understanding client needs, characteristics, and issues; as well as resources for understanding the labour market.



Group Facilitation for Career Development 小組導向職涯發展 (8 hours)

This provides first-hand experience in conducting career development facilitation in a small-group setting.



Assessment Tools and Practices 評估工具與實踐 (8 hours)

This introduces additional assessment tools and practices that address specific needs in career development.



Facilitating Career Development for Specific Targets

特定對象的職涯發展 (8 hours)

This studies the career needs, concerns, or issues of specific target groups which may often be overlooked in society.



Facilitating Career Development: The Exploring Phase

職涯發展(I):探索同行(16 hours)

This covers key areas and skills for exploration and relationship-building to form a working alliance with clients at the beginning phase of career development facilitation.



Facilitating Career Development: The Action Phase

職涯發展(Ⅲ): 行動策劃 (16 hours)

This covers key areas and practices for preparing clients for action through effective decision-making, goal-setting, as well as action-planning or programme design.



Advanced Facilitation Skills

導引技巧進深訓練 (8 hours)

This examines the workings of different micro-skills by adoping a process approach.



Career Development Theories and Practice

職涯發展理論與實務 (8 hours)

This examines a wider range of career development theories, how they may apply to culturally diverse populations, and issues that facilitators may face in the helping process.

- ii Holder of a bachelor degree or equivalent with at least2 years of working experience; OR
- iii Holder of a master degree or equivalent with at least 1 year of working experience; OR
- iv Holder of a doctorate degree or equivalent.

Assessment Methods

Assignments, Case Studies, Experiential Group Work, Role-plays

Graduation Requirements

- i An attendance rate of 70% or above in each course.
- ii Completion of all the EIGHT courses. Participants must obtain an overall pass in each course.
