### Biography

**Dr. Huang** is currently a post-doctorate fellow at JC School of Public Health and Primary Care, CUHK, funded by Research Grants Council (RGC) of Hong Kong Government and Special Outstanding Faculty Postdoctoral Fellowship Scheme (FPFS) of CUHK. He received PhD in Public Health at CUHK. He was awarded an MSc in Clinical and Translational Research at University College Dublin, Ireland. He also had a Medical Degree and is a licensed clinician of Internal Medicine in China.

He received more than ten international and local research awards for his outstanding public health and cancer research, including the *President's Prize for Best Paper* for Oral Presentation at Annual Scientific Meeting of the Hong Kong College of Community Medicine (HKCCM) in 2022; *Cancer Research Award* from Yu To Sang and Yu Shing Keung Memorial Fund, Hong Kong in 2021; *Young Investigator Award* (*YIA*) *Oral Presentation* in International Digestive Disease Forum (IDDF) from the GUT BMJ journal in 2021; *Young Investigator Travel Grant Award* for Oral Presentation in Asian Pacific Digestive Week (APDW) from Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology in India in2019; *Oral Presentation Award* in the National University Cancer Institute Singapore (NCIS) Annual Research Meeting (NCAM), National University of Singapore in2019; and *Early Career Researcher Award* for Oral Presentation in Annual Cancer and Primary Care Research Network (Ca-Pri), University of Toronto in 2019.

Dr. Huang's research focus on Cancer Epidemiology and Prevention, Primary Care Education and Promotion, and other Public Health Topics. He has participated in a total of 15 funded research projects (9.6 million HKD). Among them, he is the PI/Co-PI of five current research projects, including HMRF and Quotation Projects from Hospital Authority of HK (a total of 4.2 million HKD). He has published more than 100 full-text publications and over 40 abstracts (Google Scholar total citations: 3931; H-index: 24) in international peer-review journals, including those top-tier journals, such as *Lancet*, *Nature Reviews Gastroenterology & Hepatology, Gastroenterology, Lancet Hematology, Gut, Journal of Hematology and Oncology, European Urology, Liver Cancer, Clinical Gastroenterology and Hepatology, American Journal of Gastroenterology, Chest, European Journal of Epidemiology, Journal of the Royal Society of Medicine*, and British Journal of Sports Medicine.

He has been very active in attending academic conferences. He had more than 100 oral and poster presentations in a wide range of countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, South Korea, Japan, Singapore, the Philippines, Malaysia, India, and China; and renown international, national and local Universities, such as Oxford University, Queen Mary University of London, University of Toronto, National University of Singapore, University of Malaya, Peking University, Fudan University, Chinese University of Hong Kong, and the University of Hong Kong.

Dr. Huang currently serves in the editorial board of *Hong Kong Medical Journal, Journal of Korean Medical Science, Frontiers in Oncology, Cancer Screening and Prevention,* and *Public Health Challenges*. Recently, he was invited to be a guest editor in the *European Journal of Cancer Care* for a special issue on 'Cancer Control in Asia-Role for Primary Care'; *Frontiers in Public health* for a special issue on 'Cancer Burden, Prevention and Treatment in Developing Countries'; as well as *Vaccines* for a special issue on 'Vaccination Intention against the COVID-19 Pandemic'.
